Good Afternoon Caroline

Thank you for your email. We are pleased to report we are all well and looking forward to easing of lockdown restrictions and some return to normality.

Our current focus is on the ongoing archaeological and geological pre-construction survey work being conducted on the applicants' behalf along the landfall, cable route and substation sites. These have not been without incident causing a great deal of concern to the local community and visitors. Following a TEAMS call with the Stakeholder Manager and various members of the survey team we are reaching an understanding and some advance notice of the nature of works involved. We are hopeful these meetings will become a regular feature of these works and will form part of the future communication strategy should these projects be consented.

We also note the Secretary of State BEIS has recently deferred a decision on a second offshore windfarm, Norfolk Boreas, until later in the year.

With respect to ISH17 we have reviewed the proposed agenda and the recently published ExQ3 along with responses to deadlines 8, 9 & 10 and do not consider we have anything further to add to the Outline DCO application discussion at this time.

We will closely monitor proceedings via Livestream or published transcripts and respond as necessary at deadlines 11 - 12.

Should this decision change and we wish to take part in ISH 17 we will contact you further to arrange for joining instructions.
