

1	Attached are the 2020 Annual Report and Financial Statements for The Church of St Mary the Virgin, Friston which is threatened by the development proposals and cumulative effects locally. It demonstrates a living church, even in these most difficult times, striving to meet the needs of the community. As we approach the easing of lockdown restrictions and anticipate the joys of our landscape and the Spring and Summer, our landscape has been destroyed by the advent of investigation groundworks which will extend throughout the summer. In the cause of climate change and renewable energy: - the land has been poisoned - we have lost spring wildlife and birdsong	Noted. The Applicants have proivded an updated on the progress and status of the ground investigation (GI) works within the <i>Applicants' Statement</i> <i>Regarding Ground Investigation Works Update</i> submitted at Deadline 10 (REP10-029). The Applicants note that the photographs provided within FPCC's submission at Deadline 10 (REP10-047) show the additional archaeological trial trenching surveys, as were agreed with Suffolk County Council's Archaeology Service (SCCAS), as supported by statement LA-06.03 of the Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) with East Suffolk Council (ESC) and Suffolk County Council (SCC) (REP8-114). The objective of the trial trenching surveys is to identify unknown buried archaeological features not captured within existing records and to complement the data gathered during the archaeological geophysical surveys (detailed magnetometry), the results of which are presented within <i>Appendix 24.4</i> of the Environmental Statement (ES) (APP-515 to APP-516).
	- we have lost walking routes.	The Applicants note the aim of the GI works is to further characterise the geotechnical, geo-environmental, thermal and electrical properities of soils within the onshore development area. This would assit with early delivery of the Projects and the scope of such works, has also included preliminary infiltration testing. The Applicants note that these works are temporary, and the land will be reinstated to its original condition on completion of the investigatory works.
