We would like to provide full endorsement of deadline 11 submissions from SASES:

Specifically on the issues of flood risk to Friston during substation construction and if consented during operation. It is clear that the proposals represent a potential to pose an ongoing increased flood risk to Friston village and peoples homes.

We live off [REDACTED] our home is just a few metres from the existing storm drainage ditch and has not been flooded since improvements were made by the Environment Agency many years ago.

**Development of substations at Grove Wood site with SPRs proposed water management would put our property and other properties nearby at a new and increased risk of flooding and this surely can not be acceptable?**

The report by GWP Consultants, GWP Report No.210602 submitted by SASES highlights the many inconsistencies in SPR's surface water management proposals and the clear failures in how they propose to engineer and safely manage the site's pluvial water issues. We are equally concerned that Suffolk County Council also remain unconvinced of Scottish Power's water management proposals and strongly urge the Inspectorate to ensure that our village and homes are not put at future risk by these proposals.
