Procedural decision on changes to the application

I am writing to advise you of a procedural decision by the Examining Authority (ExA) in relation to changes to the application submitted at Deadline 11.

Having regard to proposed changes to the application submitted to the Examination at Deadline 11 by East Anglia TWO Limited (referred to as 'the Applicant') and to guidance in the Planning Inspectorate's Advice Note 16: Requesting Changes ('AN16'), the ExA has decided that the proposed changes are not material changes. The ExA has accepted the proposed changes for Examination on that basis.

This procedural decision is set out in full **in Annex A** to this letter. The procedural decisions tracker has been re-published to take account of these decisions and is provided in **Annex B**.

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Procedural Decision made by the Examining Authorities

The Examining Authorities (ExAs) have made the following procedural decision¹. Previous procedural decisions can be accessed from the Procedural Decisions Tracker in Annex B.

35. Proposed changes to the applications at Deadline 11: Land near Ness House and the Wardens Trust

At Deadline 11 in each Examination, East Anglia ONE North Limited and East Anglia TWO Limited (referred to as 'the Applicants') submitted a request to reduce the land required onshore [REP11-053] ² in the following locations:

- Remove Plot 10 in its entirety from the area near Ness House/Wardens Trust;
 and
- Reduce the size of plots 12 and 13 immediately to the north of plot 10³.

As a consequence, it is anticipated that Requirement 12(18)(e), which relates to the working width of the onshore cable route in proximity to the transition bays forming part of Work No 8, would be amended at Deadline 12 to reduce the maximum working width within this area from 190m to 113m, following the removal of Plot 10.

The ExAs have considered the changes and responses to them, and have concluded that these changes are non-material, for reasons set out below. It follows that no formal acceptance, notice, consultation or related process is required before the ExAs commence examination of these proposed changes, which the ExAs have done with immediate effect, alongside the applications as submitted. This agreement by the ExAs does not imply any acceptance of the planning merits or evidence for the changes, the effects of which will be examined with equal rigour to the proposals contained in the original applications.

The Examining Authorities' reasoning

In reaching this decision, the ExAs note that the proposed changes do not extend the land affected by the applications. Both have the effect of reducing the land required for the proposed developments. In comparison with the scale of the proposed developments as a whole, the land affected by the changes is only minor in extent.

The Applicants have provided reasoning which suggests that the proposed developments can be delivered without the need for the land which is proposed be excluded.

The changes appear intended to have the effect of reducing the extent and or adversity of environmental effects (and so appear likely to be within the Rochdale envelopes for the proposed developments). Whilst the ExAs make no judgement yet as to whether the proposed changes will reduce adverse effects, they accept that there is no likelihood that the exclusion of this land will lead to any material exacerbation of adverse effects.

On this basis and having taken the advice in AN16⁴ fully into account, the ExAs accept that the changes described above are not material changes to the applications.



Log of Procedural Decisions made by the Examining Authorities

The ExAs have made the following groups of procedural decisions⁵:

- Procedural decisions made in the pre-examination period before the Preliminary Meeting, initially to support Examination including physical hearing events before the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic, and then to ensure continued preparation for Examination using Covid-safe methods. There are 19 of these decisions, numbered in date order from 1 to 19, of which 5 have been superseded and cancelled and 14 remain in effect having been confirmed following the Preliminary Meetings.
- **Procedural decisions made following the Preliminary Meetings**. There are three of these, numbered in sequence from 20 to 22. These decisions are set out in full in the **Rule 8 Letters** of 12 October 2020. Noting that some elements of these decisions were contested in written and oral submissions to the Preliminary Meetings, a statement of reasons was also provided and can be accessed by a hyperlink from those letters.
- **Procedural decisions made during the Examinations**. There are currently 13 of these, numbered 23 to 35, relating to:
 - PD 23: requests by the Applicants for changes to the applications including the inclusion of additional land.
 - PD 24: a decision by the ExA not to issue a second round of written questions (ExO2).
 - PD 25: a decision by the ExA to accept non-material revisions to details of the onshore substations (updated details of finished ground levels and height of structures).
 - PD 26: a decision by the ExA to amend the timetables to respond to requests by the Applicants for changes to the applications and to provide additional time for Open Floor and Issue Specific Hearings.
 - PD 27: publication of Questions on the Energy White Paper (December 2020) under EPR Rule 17.
 - PD 28: amendment of Timetable to accommodate revised hearings in February 2021.
 - PD 29: Examination process decisions for additional Affected Persons under the Infrastructure Planning (Compulsory Acquisition) Regulations 2010.
 - PD 30: amendment of Timetable to accommodate revised hearings in March 2021.

- PD 32: a decision by the ExA to accept non-material reductions to the land required at the proposed landfall and the crossing of the Hundred River .
- PD 33: Amendment of timetable to accommodate a decision by the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy to extend the examination period for each application to 6 July 2021.
- o **PD 34**: A decision to accept as non-material a proposed change to each application relating to land adjacent to Ness House (plot 13).
- PD 35: A decision to accept as non-material a proposed change to each application relating to land adjacent to Ness House (plots 10, 12 and 13) (this letter).


