- 1. It is apparent from 'Natural England Deadline 12 submission Appendix C11' <u>REP12-091</u> paras 4 and 5 that it has been given to understand that 'the proposed works are on the margins of the woodland' and therefore may enjoy different ecological conditions from the surrounding woodland. That does not seem to be correct.
- 2. The Applicants' have stated that the contractors would need to use a 40m wide area of the woodland for up to 64m along the Hundred River's west bank during construction of the Watercourse Crossing and for its associated vehicle movements and equipment.
 - An existing small clearing may be included the area of works, depending upon final siting of the cable corridors.
 - However, much of the woodland surrounding it would be within the area of works.
- 3. A SASES 'birds eye view' map of Works 19 was prepared for ExA Accompanied Site Inspection 2. This also serves to illustrate the current disposition of trees within the Order Limits at Works No 19 (see below).
