**Application by East Anglia TWO Limited (“the Applicant”) for an Order granting Development Consent for the proposed East Anglia TWO Offshore Wind Farm and associated offshore and onshore infrastructure (“the East Anglia TWO project”)**

1. The Secretary of State has received a request for clarification regarding his consultation letter of 2 November 2021 as to whether it should have referred to flood events rather than any single flood event. As such, the Secretary of State requests that the Environment Agency consider all relevant flood events in their response to his consultation, including those for which details were submitted by local residents during the examination.
