Dear Sirs

Do not give Scottish Power permission to build a Substation at Friston. I have seen the flooding caused at Friston by the exploration works alone. Beyond flooding this Area of outstanding Natural Beauty should be preserved for our children. Biodiversity loss risks 'ecological meltdown' - we KNOW this.

The UK has an average of only 53% of its biodiversity left, well below the global average, why would you allow this situation to get worse by choosing a green field site rather than a brownfield site. You must make a split decision, Green must mean Green. Yes to off shore wind power , yes to bringing it onshore on an already industrialised brownfield site.
