Re: National Grid Interconnector Holdings Limited - request for access for non-intrusive surveys - Title Number: SK346948

I am one of the owners of the land referenced in this request to access parts of our property for NGIHL to carry out “non-intrusive surveys for Nautilus Interconnector Projects” and am responding to your letters of 2nd December and 17th December.

Could you please clarify the following.

1. The hatched area for your survey excludes our paddock which protrudes straight through the center. Can you confirm that you will not be needing to access this land.
2. Is the area being surveyed a proposed site for an interconnector or part of the cable route?
3. The National Grid document entitled “Payments schedule for new electricity transmission assets” states on the second page that “Whilst voluntary agreement is always sought, National Grid has statutory rights to gain access to land for surveys and investigations works”. Could you provide further details of these rights including the relevant statutory provisions.
4. We have also had a request from the representatives of National Grid Electricity Transmission (NGET) SEA link project to survey sections of this land, in addition there is the sister project to Nautilus called Eurolink. I assume that the results of these surveys will be used for those projects. Could you please confirm.
