Dear Sir/Madam

Regarding the development proposals put forward by Scottish Power Renewables in the Sizewell Area I would like to suggest the following option.

I am aware that SPR has not approached EDF regarding use of their land because of the potential development of Sizewell C. However, the land that was to be used by EDF for compound and car parking for the build has now been allocated as wildlife habitat. This land is ideal for development by SPR as it is in a good location i.e. north of Sizewell Gap Road therefore keeping industrial development in one place. It also has the benefit of no direct impact on properties, its close proximity to the grid connection and direct road access.

The areas that SPR are proposing to use will effectively destroy very well established habitat in the area, so surely the best solution is to use the land recently put down for habitat and wildlife by EDF.

I realise the difficulty in obtaining land belonging to EDF but Greater Gabbard and Golloper Windfarms successfully negotiated to place their substations close to Sizewell A.

In the light that National Grid has decided to allow grid connection in the Sizewell area instead of the options of connecting via Lowestoft or Bawdsey please consider this option I put forward
