Vanguard Offshore Wind Farm

We are writing concerning the above. While, in principle, we have no problems with windfarms, we would like the following to be requested as part of the statement we have put together a short list of the environmental statement:

1. Identification of the area over which biological effects may occur to inform baseline data collection and determining the connectivity between key wildlife (and specifically marine) populations and proposed wind energy sites.
2. The methodology proposed to monitor impacts into a wildlife (and specifically marine) population level context and the actions to be taken to determine whether they are biologically significant.
3. How responses will be measured during wind farm construction and operation to determine disturbance effects and avoidance responses.
4. What efforts will be made (including learning from other industries and similar

projects) to inform risk assessments and the effectiveness of mitigation measures, particularly given this will be a further offshore wind development along the same stretch of coast where there is now likely to be a growing need to consider the population level consequences and cumulative impacts of these activities on wildlife/marine species.

5. Specific sections/details on how public perception is to be addressed as part of the EIA – particularly given this is a tourist area and with the proximity of a number of AOB and numerous SSSI.
6. Will coastal process modelling be used – and made available to the public – for the proposed windfarm development?
7. Impact of onshore locations and routes - both during construction and then operation - and how these impacts will be addressed/mitigated on the following:
 - a. Air and noise pollution
 - b. Volume of traffic/Overall traffic management
 - c. Existing wildlife and their habitats
 - d. Compatibility with the Shore Line Management Plan (SMP) and the position that the area around Mundesley/Bacton will be a managed retreat.
