Consultation from 7th November 2017 to 11th December 2017

Section 42 Planning Act 2008

Norfolk Vanguard Limited (the **Applicant**) intends to develop and construct an offshore wind farm located more than 47km from the coast of Norfolk (the **Project**).

The Project will have an installed capacity of around 1,800 MW and therefore falls within the definition of a "Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project" (**NSIP**). As a result, the Applicant is required to submit an application for a Development Consent Order (**DCO**) to the Planning Inspectorate (**PINS**), who will examine the application on behalf of the Secretary of State.

The offshore array is located in the northern half of the former Zone 5 (East Anglia Zone) in the North Sea, which is being developed as two individual wind farms, both of which will require the appropriate statutory consents and approvals. The Project is the first to be proposed.

The Project relates to the construction and operation of an offshore wind farm covering an offshore area of approximately 592 km² over two distinct areas (Norfolk Vanguard East and Norfolk Vanguard West), which are located in the southern North Sea approximately 70km and 47km from the coast of Norfolk, respectively (at the nearest points) and will connect to the National Grid via underground cables to the National Grid substation at Necton, Norfolk.

Norfolk Boreas Limited (another affiliate company of Vattenfall Wind Power Limited) is developing Norfolk Boreas Offshore Wind Farm, which is entirely separate to the Project and will submit its own DCO application. Norfolk Boreas would share a grid connection location and also much of the offshore and onshore cable corridors with Norfolk Vanguard. Therefore, in order to minimise impacts, the Applicant will include within its DCO application some enabling works for the Norfolk Boreas project. Further information in relation to this can be found in more detail in the Non-Technical Summary of the Preliminary Environmental Information Report (**PEIR**).

Consultation on the Project

You may already have been contacted by PINS in connection with our proposals when it requested your comments on the Applicant's Environmental Impact Assessment (**EIA**) Scoping Report. PINS has since published its Scoping Opinion for the Project which can be viewed on the website at https://infrastructure.planninginspectorate.gov.uk/. The Scoping Opinion has informed the EIA carried out for the Project and the results of the EIA to date are reported within the Applicant's PEIR.
