My firm acts for the National Trust, who have submitted relevant representations against the DCO. The National Trust owns land within the limits of the order as shown on the land plans.

I am writing to inform you that it is not the intention of the Trust to attend the preliminary meeting on 10 December. The National Trust is content with the examination timetable and that its three main concerns, namely archaeology, traffic and land acquisition are within the scope of the Initial Assessment of Principle Issues as set out in the Rule 6 letter.

The one request that the National Trust would make is that if, after discussion with the local authorities and Historic England, it concludes that there would be value in it participating in the proposed statement of common ground on archaeology, then the applicant should give it the opportunity to do so.
