### **Deadline 2 Submissions**

We write further to the Planning Inspectorate's Rule 8 letter dated 19 December 2019 (the **Rule 8 letter**). In accordance with the deadlines at Annex A of the Rule 8 letter, we enclose the following in response to Deadline 2:

- 1. The Applicant's comments on Written Representations
- The Applicant's comments on responses to the ExA's Written Questions
- 3. The Applicant's comments on Local Impact Reports
- Revised draft DCO (clean and tracked change versions) from the Applicant alongside a DCO changes tracker and a revised draft Explanatory Memorandum (clean and tracked change versions)
- 5. Response to the Planning Inspectorate's Rule 17 letter dated 22 January 2019 addressed to the Ministry of Defence and Norfolk Vanguard Limited.

Whilst the Applicant notes that the Examining Authority did not require comments on additional submissions, the Applicant has, where relevant, responded to these submissions through the Applicant's Response to Written Representations (document reference: ExA; WRR: 10.D2.2), or the Applicant's Response to Written Questions (document reference: ExA; WQR; 10.D2.3).

The Applicant has also included revised draft application documents which capture changes from the Planning Inspectorate's section 51 advice (dated 24 July 2018) and, should the Examining Authority accept into the Examination the proposed changes identified in the Change Report (document reference: Pre-ExA; Change Report; 9.3) (the **Change Report**), the updates also capture amendments resulting from these proposed changes. Where appropriate, the Applicant has submitted a "tracked change" version of these documents alongside the clean version for ease of reference.

# **Additional Late Submissions**

Through correspondence with the Planning Inspectorate, the Applicant understands that there was an error in uploading some submissions, namely and in particular the appendices associated with the George Freeman, M.P. letter dated 11 January 2019. The Applicant has been informed that the error was rectified on Monday 28 January 2019 and that a new version of the letter, complete with appendices, was uploaded on this date. In view of the short timeframe between the upload of the full letter (complete with appendices) and Deadline 2 (Wednesday 30 January 2019), the Planning Inspectorate has suggested that it would be appropriate to respond to this submission at Deadline 3 (Thursday 14 February 2019). Accordingly, the Applicant will respond to this letter in full as part of the Applicant's submissions at Deadline 3.

## **Change Report Landowner Consents**

As part of the Applicant's Responses to the ExA's First Written Questions (document reference: ExA; WQ; 10.D1.3), the Applicant stated that it would provide an update on the status of landowners negotiations for the "additional land" included within Change Report. The Applicant can confirm that (1) all landowners and tenants of the additional land have given their consent to the inclusion of compulsory acquisition powers within the DCO and (2) the Applicant relies on condition 3 of Section 123 of the Planning Act 2008 for inclusion of compulsory acquisition powers over the additional land in this respect. Figure 1. Land Plan showing land before additional land amendment

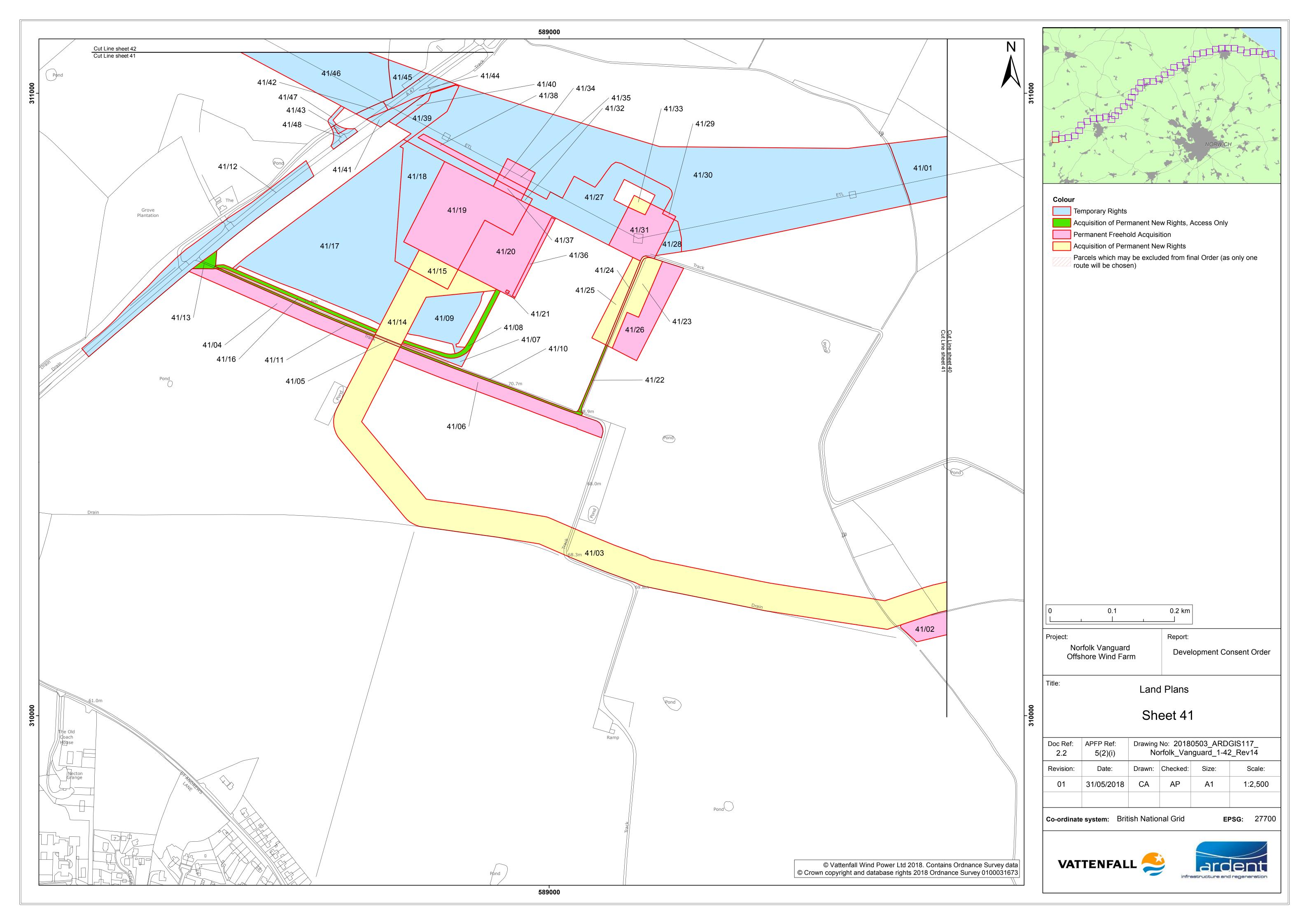
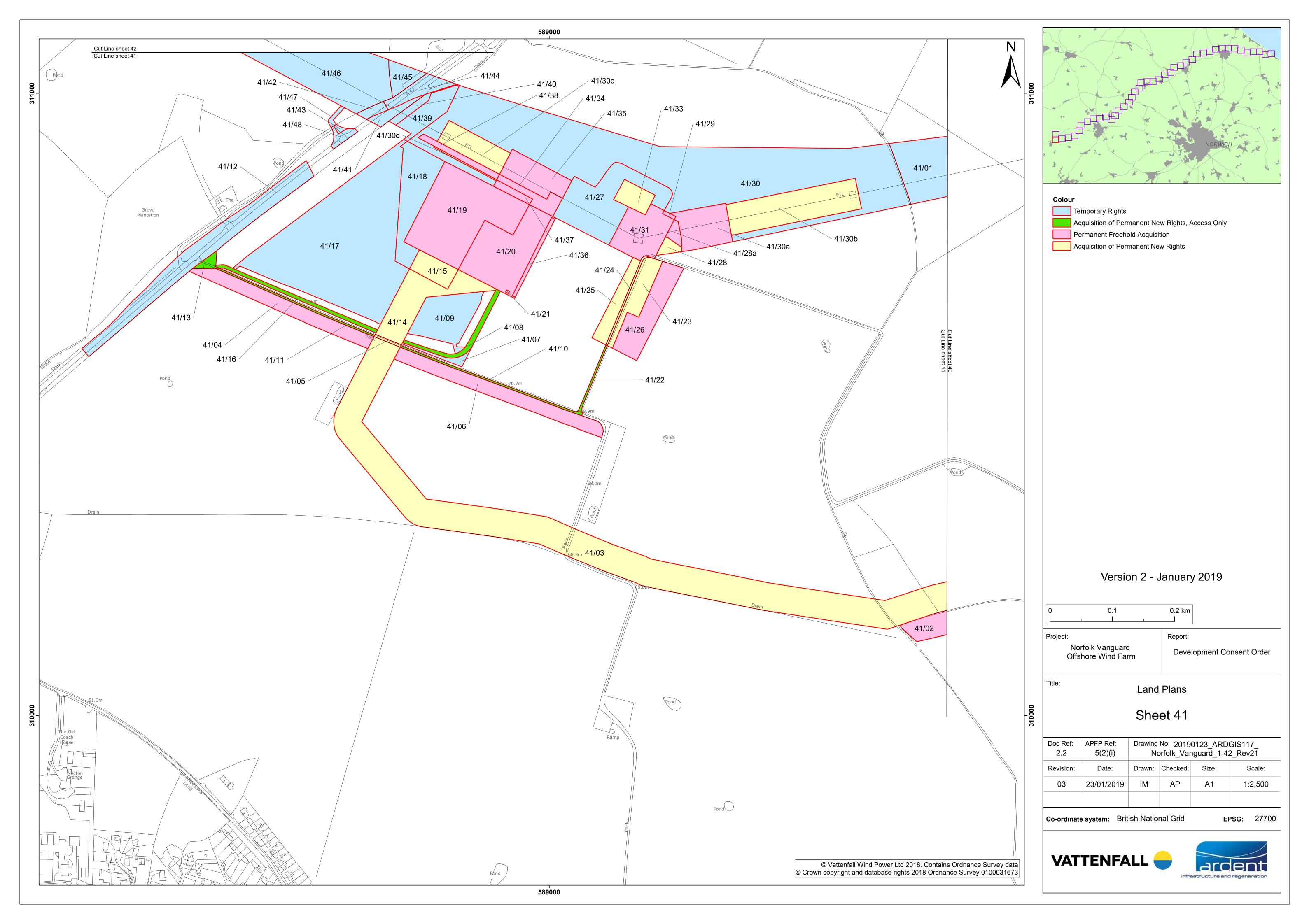




Figure 2. Land Plan showing land after additional land amendment

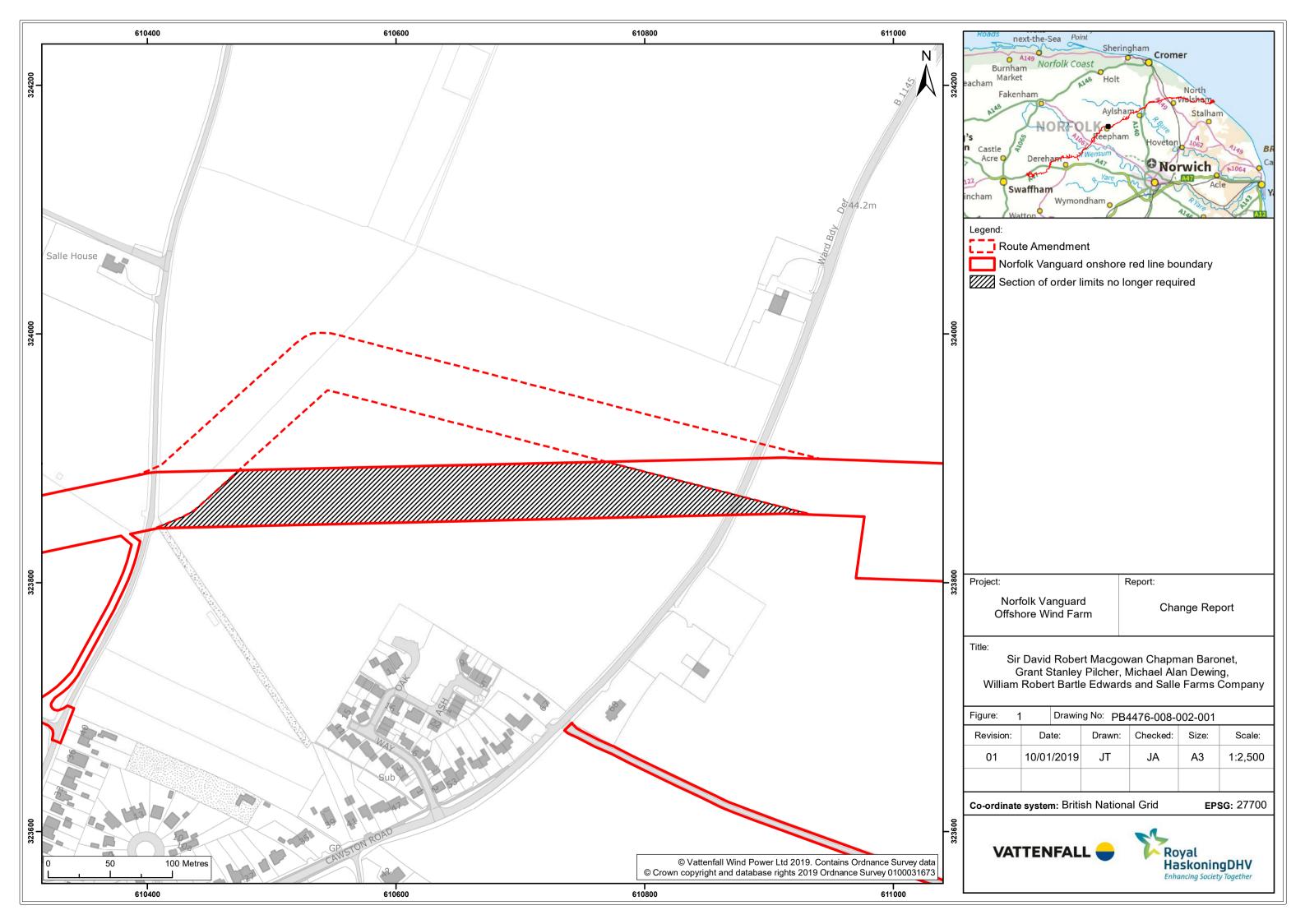

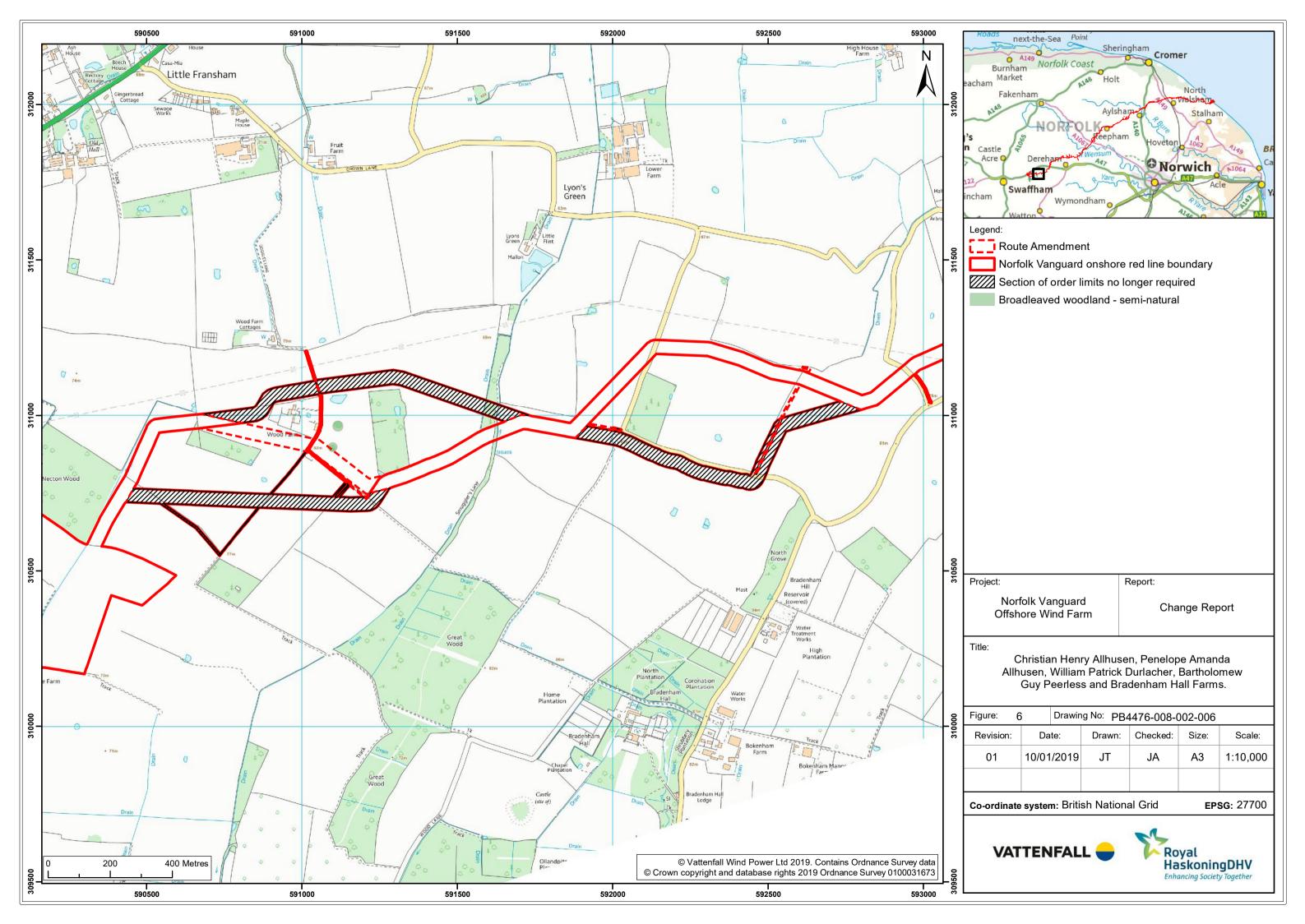

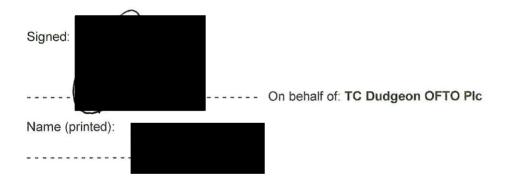




Figure 1. Plan showing land before additional land amendment

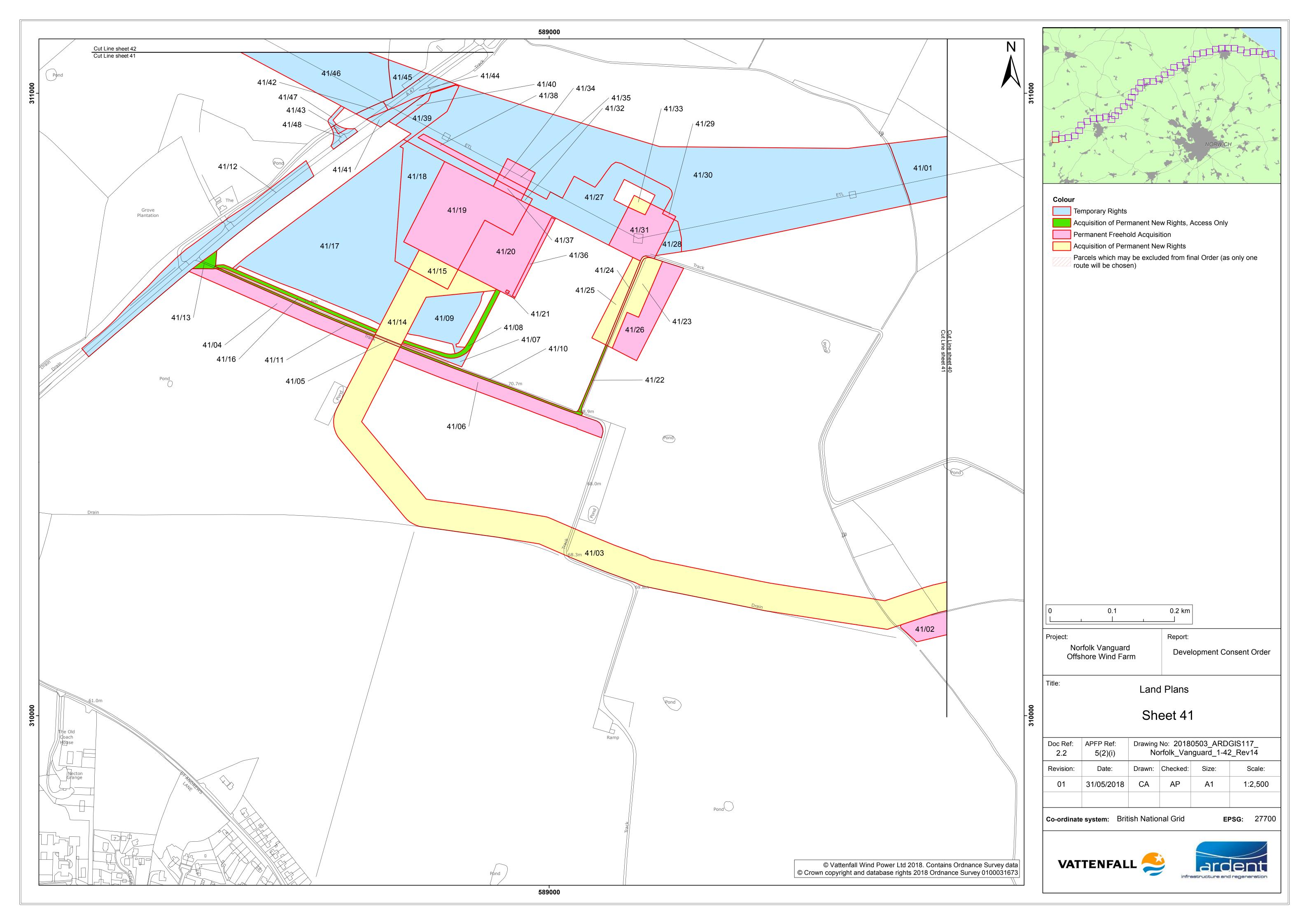
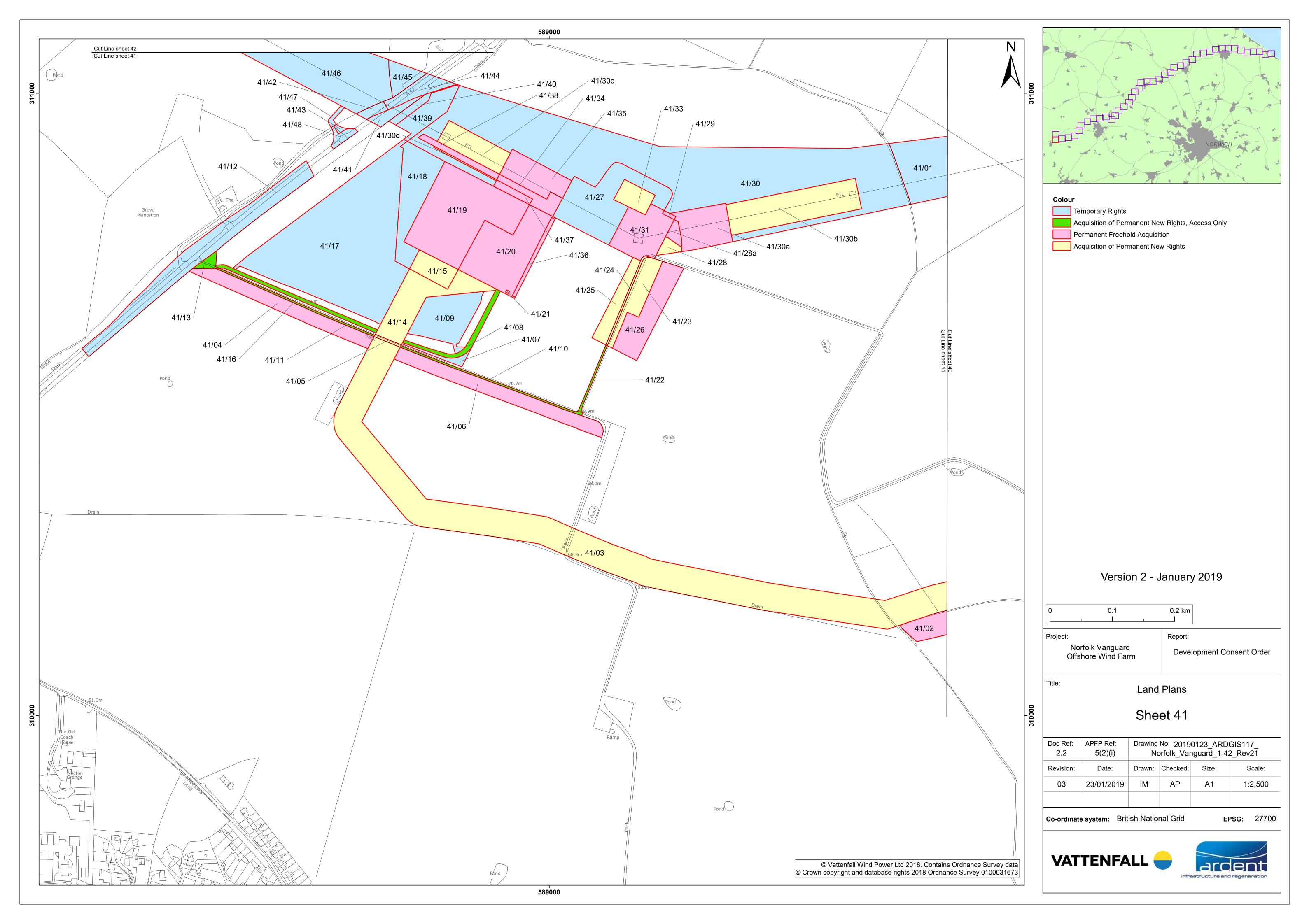




Figure 2. Plan showing land after additional land amendment

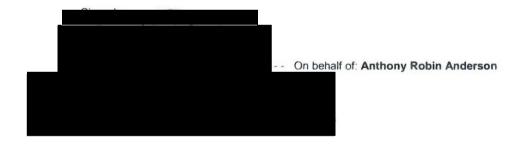


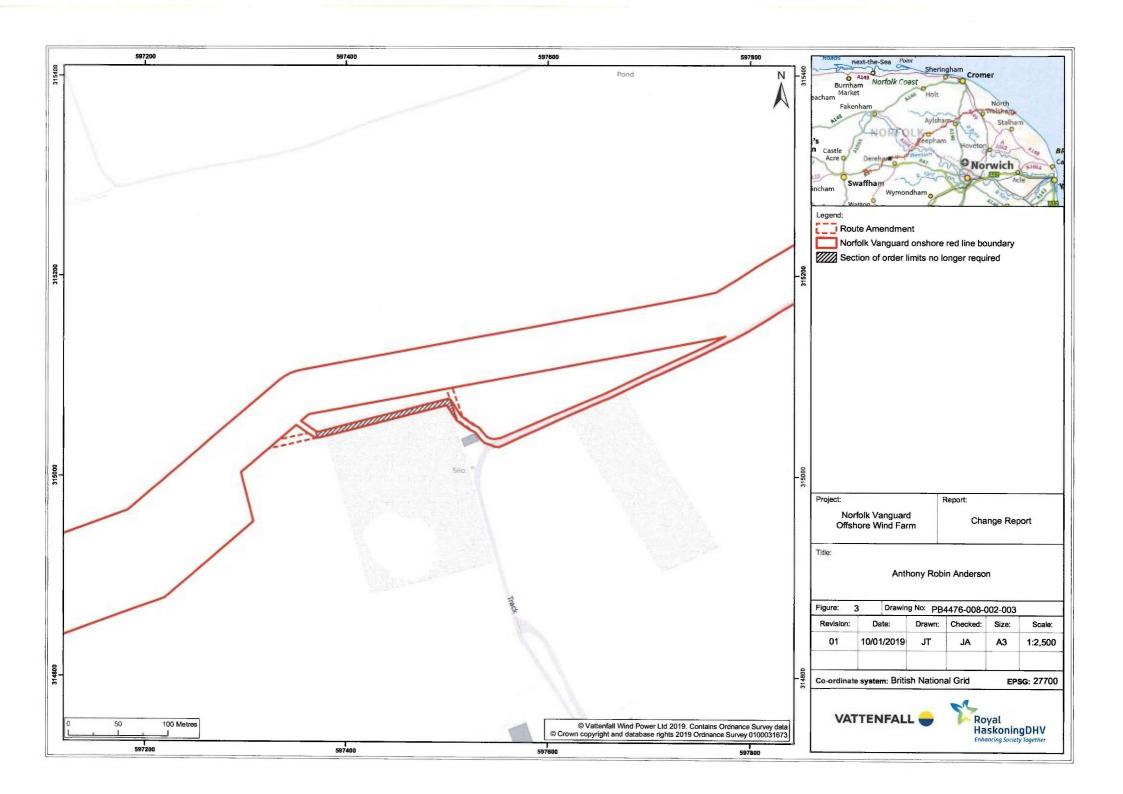

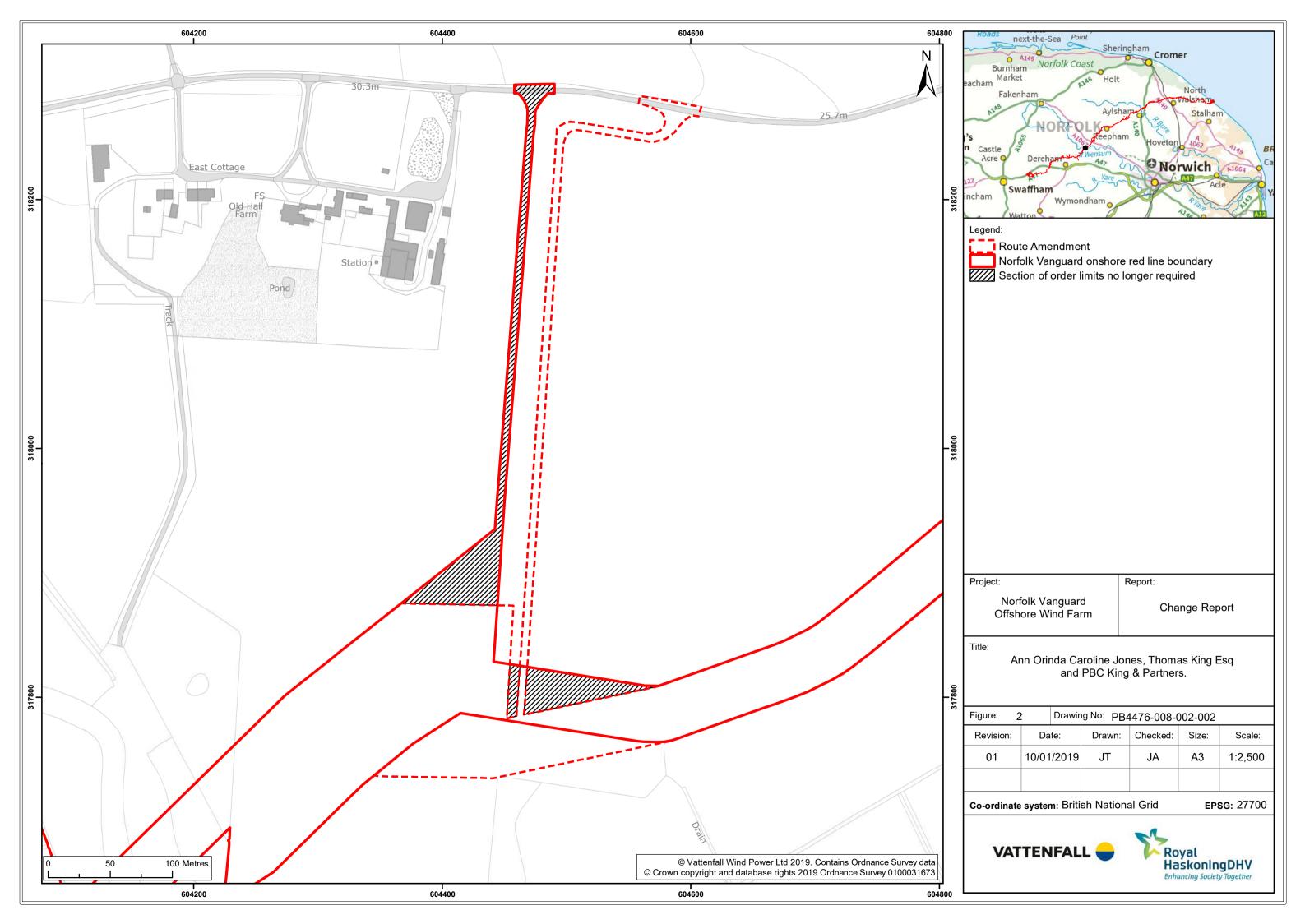
