1. the protective provisions for the benefit of Network Rail and
2. the property and asset protection agreements

as referred to in Network Rail's Written Representations dated 16 January 2019 [REP1-063].

Network Rail and the applicant are in ongoing discussions regarding these documents and Network Rail hopes to resolve any matters of disagreement in the coming weeks.
