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

My wife and I live in West End and are constituents of yours.

We own Westbrooke Holiday complex in West End and have been very distressed at the proposal by Vattenfall to build giant substations that will seriously damage our business.

We have been shown 4 footprints, and none of them are suitable for this area, being too large. We have been told that the build alone will take 10 years to complete and that after this the company will return every summer for up to 2 months to carry out 24/7 maintenance. This will of course be our peak period.

The worst footprints from our point of view would be option 4, followed by 2, 3 and 1.

Our visitors come from the USA, France, Australia, Holland, Germany and the UK. They bring binoculars and astronomy telescopes with which to observe the night skies and wildlife, predominantly bats. (We have had a survey done around our property and have discovered we have at least 4 different species). A lot of our tourist visitors are repeat bookings because we have a reputation built up with many years of hard work that our properties are ideal for such activities, which all need dark skies. Our experience with Dudgeon has shown us that the light pollution created by these industrial projects is horrendous.

Why should people like ourselves who have worked very hard to build a successful business have it damaged by this company with no compensation and with our views having been ignored? In fact the whole of West End was been left out of the consultation right up until the last minute.

We would be more than happy to invite you to visit our premises to show you that they are 4/5 Star tourist attractions.

We would ask that you act on our behalf in this matter and give you our permission to do so.



I am writing to you to let you know my thoughts regarding the Necton substations, and in particular the four proposed site options. I do not think any of the footprints are suitable and I am very distressed and worried to think that we will be forced to have to live in close proximity to 70 acres of substation construction. It makes me feel very threatened and I know it will have a seriously negative impact on my daily life. I am not just concerned for myself and my family but also for all the other families who will be affected also.

I worry that Vattenfall haven't truly considered any other possible sites for their substations to be built on. Our villages will be irreversibly damaged and once the substations have outlived their use and technology moves on, the catastrophic legacy will be with us and future generations forever.

I think that option 1 is on too high ground, option 2 is too close to Ivy Todd Farm and is on high ground, option 3 is too close to Necton and threatens archaeology. Option 4 is positioned in the valley and would be unbearable for us to live with. It could never be successfully screened. Our villages are simply not suitable for this kind of development to be built in. Please come and view our farm and see exactly what we mean.

I am filled with dread when I think of the years of construction work that we would be forced to live with, and equally to have to live with the end result.

Please will you represent my views at future meetings.

My husband and I are residents of Necton.

We - along with the NSAG - have been fighting against the proposed Substation which Vattenfall are trying to build close to our village. This impending structure will not only have an immense impact on the village itself and also on Ivy Todd but also on lives of the residents and the value of their properties. We have already have to contend with the existing substation - Dudgeon - on our doorstep and to impose another on such a small community will be catastrophic. We have been given 4 footprints to consider for the building of the Substation - none of which in our opinion is acceptable. We have been told that if we are forced to opt for one of the options - which one would we choose.

Option 1 - Although furthest from the village of Necton and Ivy Todd it is on high

Option 2 - This being too close to Ivy Todd

Option 3 - Being too close to Necton and archaeology.

Option 4 - Being too close to Ivy Todd and archaeology.

Another option is Top Farm although not a footprint on offer - but this would also involve National Grid extensions - and again would be seen from A47.

In our opinion neither of the above options are acceptable to us

The only acceptable option in our view is Scarning. This is because it would remove the cable corridor from Bradenham Hall Farm and save 10km of cabling which would be necessary for erecting both Vanguard and Boreas. It would avoid ruining Necton Farm. Scarning area would be large enough to take a NG substation - being open land with the possible effect on probably only 2 dwellings. Our understanding is that it is land that will already have a cable route through it and so makes sense and would also have direct access to the A47.

Why should we be given an option of 4 footprints- all of which we cannot accept - when the one blinding acceptable option for us all would be Scarning.

I am writing once again with regards to the proposed substations in the Necton vicinity. Firstly, I would like to thank you for your support of the Necton community and its efforts to overcome having this monstrosity on its doorstep. It is appalling that Vattenfall have no regard for the government of this country or its citizens and have decided not to participate in future meetings with yourself and the community. It is particularly galling that it is not a British company and as they themselves have admitted the proposed substations will provide minimal employment benefits to the community. It is surprising that even now some residents believe that it will create a large number of permanent local jobs, free electricity to residents for life and an A47 roundabout! Dream on.

I am writing to you today to make two brief points. One is that Necton should not have further substations. I would like to register my concern, and disapproval to moving the proposed substation closer to the Dudgeon substation and on lower ground, as this means closer to Ivy Todd, Necton.

As an Ivy Todd Necton resident, these are my views on the positioning of the Vattenfall construction.

Footprint 4 would bring the site to within 500m of residents, and its proximity to Ivy Todd Farm would be an unbearable, crippling, disaster. From our perspective it would be possible to see into virtually every extremity, and because of the lay of the land it would be impossible to screen. This is the footprint that has the most legitimate reasons to have been rejected by Vattenfall. NCC and Breckland, judging by their reports, would back this rejection.

Foot print 3 would be slightly better, but with similar issues as 4.

Foot print 2 is slightly more acceptable, as it's further away from Ivy Todd, and would be equal distance between Wood Farm, and Ivy Todd Farm, but it is high ground. Foot print 1 would position 1/2 of the development further away from Ivy Todd and West End Bradenham, but it's still high, and takes it to the same distance from Wood Farm, as foot print 4 would be from Ivy Todd Farm.

None of these footprints are good options.

The other possibility is to place all of the development at Scarning, which needs investigating, as there are so many issues with the suggested sites at Necton. Scarning is the first point where the cable corridor meets the 400kv power lines. Vattenfall proposes to run the cable corridor under the 400kv power lines there, and then on for another extra 2 1/2 - 3 miles, to connect at Necton. Connecting at Necton saves National Grid constructing 3 connection bays, as at Necton they can connect with 17 bays, but it would take 20 in total with Scarning. This has to be set against the reduction in cable corridor, marginal drainage capacity through Ivy Todd, increasingly apparent archaeology, associated with the Necton Moat, and the F16 plane crash site.

In my position, and the way I see the situation, this development, and its siting would have such an effect on our farm, and family that it is potentially life changing. Taking the importance of this decision into account, could I please request a visit, the next time you are in Necton, to see the situation first hand.

My name is Margaret Woodall and my family live at Willow Tree Cottage, 4 Ramm's Lane, Necton.

We have lived in Necton for 14 years and are very distressed about the very large substations threatening our homes. We have already been here before when the original substation was being discussed, originally to be considered for Little Dunham but eventually built at Necton, at the hightest visible point and which was promised not to happen.

I understand you want us to choose what we think would be the best option for the placing of the current proposed substations, which are definitely not right for this area, but should they be forced upon us, this is what we feel.

Option 1 - This would be further away from Necton and Ivy Todd but yet again would be sited on high ground.

Option 2 - Definitely too close to the Hamlet of Ivy Todd.

Option 3 - Much too close to Necton and local archaeology site

Option 4 - Again much too close to the Hamlet of Ivy Todd and archeology site.

Top Farm - A better option than 1-4 but it would still be necessary for the NG extension and would still be seen from the A47, but could probably be better hidden on low level land.

Scarning would be, in our opinion, the best option as it would avoid ruining Necton Farm, which is very productive agricultural land and would also remove the cable corridor from Bradenham Hall Farm. I believe it would also save around 10km of cabling for both substations and would also be able to take the National Grid Substation. It would be on land that is already having the cable route through it and would also have direct access to the A47 crossing area.

From past experience we find it very difficult to belive promises made at times of consultations, which is a considerable worry, in this case due to the unbelievable footprint size and height of the proposed structure so near to our village.

As you know, Vattenfall's current preferred site, footprint 2 is only 500m from boundary to Ivy Todd Farm, the closest residents.

Ivy Todd Farm is in a relatively low lying area and currently the proposed Nationally Significant Infrastructure will sit on high ground, for all to see!

But, please don't let Vattenfal move it to footprint 4 or even 3, into the lower lying area, as is closer to the residents of lvy Todd and will have an even more devastating impact.

At footprint 4, this very intrusive monstrosity will be even closer to Ivy Todd Farm House, less than 500m away. This overbearing structure, so out of character for this area, would be too close to residents; all are very concerned.

I realise low lying footprint 4 could be slightly preferable for some residents of Bradenham, keeping it well out of sight, but the current proposed footprint 2 is approx.1.5km away from them. Pushing it to footprint 4 would be ridiculously close to Ivy Todd.

This siting dilemma just reiterates the fact that it's in totally the wrong place. I feel Vattenfall are going for the easiest and cheapest option and should have put as much effort and resources into looking at alternative sites to Necton. Vattenfall appear to have focussed on getting it accepted environmentally and not given enough consideration to nearby residents.

If this has to be built at all (and I am concerned that it will be outdated before completed, as 10 years is along time in the realms of advancing technology) it should be as far away from populated areas as possible.

The Scarning site would be my 1st choice.

I am against it being positioned so close to Necton, but Top Farm is a better option than 4 the footprints offered by Vattenfall.

Then current footprint 2 is preferable of the 4, followed in descending order 1, 3 and no way at footprint 4.

I am writing to let you know my opinion regarding the positioning of the Vattenfall Substations at Necton. I am very distressed by the proposed sites being so close to resident's homes, and very distressed as to the impact this close proximity will have on individual's quality of life, as well as the impact on the county of Norfolk. This is not the first time I have brought these matters to your attention.

If I understand correctly, you are in favour of option 4 which is positioned in the valley. This would heavily impact on my family home and farm (Ivy Todd Farm) and be clearly visible within 500 metres of residents, ruining the lives of my family living there. It is impossible to screen. It would be devastating for us. It also threatens archaeology.

My family and I do not believe in trying to fight for an option that would ruin other families' lives instead of our own. We want an outcome that causes the least amount of devastation to the most amount of residents. No matter how Vattenfall decides to dress this up, the fall out will be catastrophic, and for a minimal gain of about 3% of power production. Is this really worth it? This is not a long term solution to energy production, but the fallout will be permanent and irreversible.

None of the options are acceptable -

Option 1 is on high ground, it would position half of the development further away from Ivy Todd and West End, Bradenham and takes it to the same distance from Wood Farm as 4 would be from Ivy Todd Farm,

Option 2 is too close to Ivy Todd Farm, and is on high ground,

Option 3 is too close to Necton, and has similar issues to 4 and threatens archaeology.

I don't understand why Scarning cannot be considered. It would avoid ruining Necton and Ivy Todd, would remove cable corridors from Bradenham Hall Farm, could take NG substation and save 5km of cabling for Vanguard and Boreas. It would be on land already having the cable route through it. The route would give direct access to A47 crossing area. Is this not a viable alternative?

There are many factors I do not understand regarding the proposed positioning of the substations. I believe that the National Grid is responsible for the outcome of where the Vattenfall substations will be built. If this is the case then I also believe that it is documented that they must be able to prove what other alternative sites were considered besides Necton and Ivy Todd and why these alternatives were not considered as suitable. Therefore, there should be files available to you which will show in depth studies to the same extent as the information Vattenfall provides, singing that 'it's Necton or nowhere', as quoted by Ruari Lean, giving evidence as to why these alternatives were ruled out. Does this information exist please and have you viewed it, please?

How, I wonder has Necton ended up with 2 more proposed substations, when Vattenfall is very keen to stress that they listen to the views of the residents and take on board what is said? The change to DC was not as a result of the opinion of Necton and Ivy Todd residents, but rather Vattenfall's own decision, fulfilling their own agenda. Why would residents opt for a larger construction which DC would bring?

I find it very frustrating that Vattenfall refers us as residents, to their website which is very generic and non-helpful or specific to Necton and Ivy Todd, in order to find answers to our concerns and queries. I have expressed this to them. We need an information page specifically for our villages. This is the only way to be transparent and to keep us accurately informed.

If it is your view that Necton HAS to be the receiver of further substations, and if it is your view that footprint 4 is the best option, then please may I ask that you visit our farm, Ivy Todd Farm, in order that you can explain the benefits to us as you view the proposed site position from our farm.
