Dear Glenn,

Good to speak to you a little earlier, following on from your call with Sue this morning. Thank you for your time, and for getting in touch following discussions with the Parish Council.

We accept that the initial draft SoCG does not meet Happisburgh PC's expectations and so we shall not be submitting this as it stands to the examining authority.

Instead, we agreed a small group of Norfolk Vanguard colleagues would meet with you (and if you see fit, a small working group representing HPC) in early February, for the purposes of making appropriate progress on this matter.

In addition to those matters pertaining to HPC Relevant Representations, we agreed that as a starting point for discussing the scope of SoCG, we should also consider matters pertaining to:

- Green Lane
- Decca Field
- SMP and records of erosion over recent years

If you have other suggestions, please let us know in advance of our meeting.

We would like to meet on either: afternoon of 6th Feb or eve of 7th Feb

Given all participants at the proposed meeting intend to attend the OFL in Norwich on the evening of the 6^{th} February, I suggest if we meet on the afternoon of the 6^{th} , this should be in Norwich

If we meet on the 7th, while Norwich would be better for us, we could eventually come to Happisburgh if this suits you better?

Meeting on either of these dates would enable you to go back to HPC with a proposed way forward, and then you could seek their input, before we continue to progress the SoCG together.

Dear Glenn and Jo,

Regarding the date of our meeting and how best to make progress on the SoCG – thank you for your efforts to date. I appreciate that these large projects do make real demands on the attention of local representatives, and it cannot be easy to gather people together at short notice.


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
