Good Afternoon,

I hope that my email hasn't reached you too late.

We are one of the farms being impacted by the Norfolk Vanguard cable and my major concern is the impact to the environment and how long it will take to recover. I believe that we must invest in more clean energy but not at any cost, particularly when the impact we will witness will be multiplied by the 100s across the county with future wind farm proposals.

Along with others along the Norfolk Vanguard route, we grow permanent crops that are in the ground for 10+ years and we also have a SSSI wetland. We work hard to create habitats for our wildlife and destroying trees, hedges, margins and soil contradicts our goal to preserve the environment for future generations. These habitats are sensitive and complex.

When the environmental impact is so large, we must look at alternatives to stop the cable (and future cables) coming through the Norfolk countryside, specifically considering the marine cable connection around the Coast into Walpole.

Please consider the impact on the future generations. We cannot leave them with polluted air but we can't leave them with a decimated countryside either. I believe there must be a better alternative solution.
