The Applicant's Submissions in response to Deadline 1

As set out in the Applicant's response to the ExA's written question Q1.14.8, the Applicant has revised its assessment of the total contingent liability associated with compulsory acquisition of land and rights due to the receipt of new information in respect of potential commercial and residential development land and mines and mineral developments. The Funding Statement and Annex A have therefore been updated to reflect the revised anticipated maximum-case scenario for compensation relating to that land.
