I have a tiny plot of Amenity
Utility land just 15 meters Square.

On it I have a Wildlife garden,
a Summer house, a rescue pony,
Bee Hives and an apple orchard -
my small holding is known as -

Mole orchard, Kelling paddocks
Holgate Hill, Weybourne Norfolk.

NR25 7ER and is just off an
SSSI known as Kelling Heath.

We are one of 8 paddocks that
ORSTED Wind Farms (Hornsea Project 3)
have earmarked to put across 6
high powered cables - my neighbour
Mr Joe Cook is a 167 ampere. This
respite land and paddock just 125m by
x 25 meters will also be impacted
with Six cables.

ORSTED have declared off an
agricultural field to cross our 8
paddocks and across a flat

Railway line - because it is
the easiest and cheapest route -
We have sent them two other
routes - Crossing a field and the
same railway line further up
the line - but we have had an
e-mail back from a Mr Richard Geist -
Land Manager Osted, stating that
because of a small curve in the
line - it would not be possible to
drill underground!
