

## Proposed Amendment to Requirement 15 (Surface Drainage)

### Development Consent Order

#### Hornsea Project Three

- (1) No part of the onshore HVDC/HVAC substation or onshore HVAC booster station shall commence until, in respect of that installation, a detailed surface water scheme has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority in consultation with the Lead Local Flood Authority, the Environment Agency and the relevant drainage board.
  
- (2) The detailed surface water schemes must accord with the outline code of construction practice and:
  - a. be based on sustainable drainage principles; and
  - b. an assessment of the hydrological and hydrogeological context of the onshore HVDC/HVAC substation or onshore HVAC booster station, as applicable;
  - c. include detailed designs of a surface water drainage scheme.
  
- (3) In this requirement, the "relevant drainage board" has the meaning of section 23 of the Land Drainage Act 1991.
  
- (4) Construction of the onshore HVDC/HVAC substation or HVAC booster station, as applicable, must be carried out in accordance with the approved scheme.
