APPLICATION BY ORSTED HORNSEA PROJECT THREE (UK) LIMITED FOR AN ORDER GRANTING DEVELOPMENT CONSENT FOR THE HORNSEA PROJECT THREE OFFSHORE WIND FARM

We write on behalf of Sir Edward Evans-Lombe of Park House, Great Melton, Norfolk, NR9 3BJ in reply to the Responses to the Examining Authority's Written Questions with reference to question 1.1.12 "Alternatives & design flexibility".

This is not a matter of contract as between the generators or between them and the National Grid but rather a matter of planning policy. If the planners take the view that the existing intentions of the generators unnecessarily increase the cost and loss of amenity to the public, they should make the grant of a Development Consent Order conditional on the generators exchanging their ultimate objectives.

We request that the alternative routes previously suggested be given further consideration within the examination process.
