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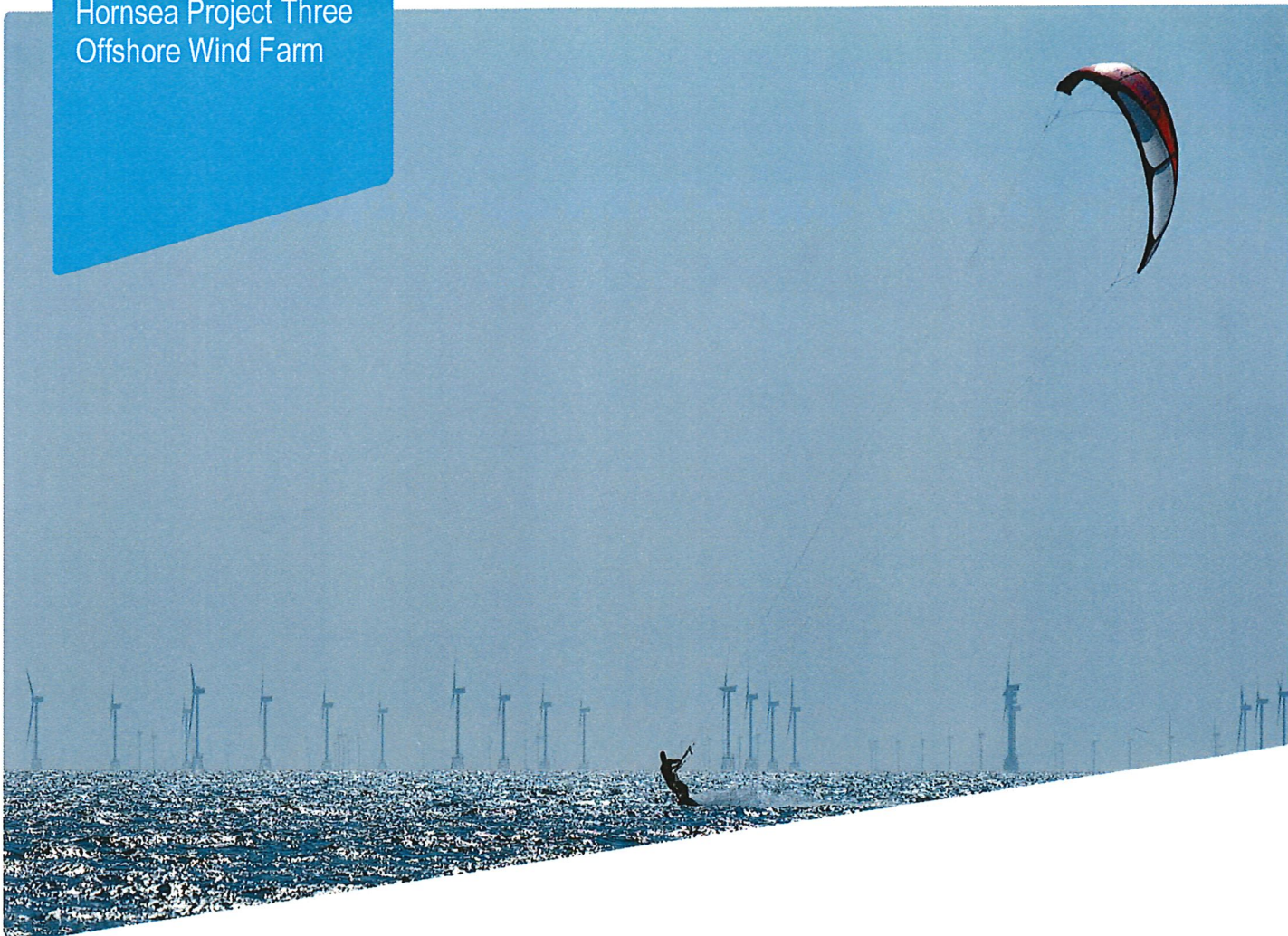

1. Statement

- 1.1 This Position Statement between Hornsea Project Three (UK) Ltd (the "Applicant") and Shell UK Ltd ("Shell") in relation to Hornsea Project Three Offshore Wind Farm ("Hornsea Three") has been prepared for submission as part of the Hornsea Three DCO Examination process to show the present status of discussions between the Applicant and Shell.
- 1.2 The two parties acknowledge that consultation between the Applicant and Shell with respect to Hornsea Three is ongoing.
- 1.3 Following submission of application [EN010080] ("Application"), Shell submitted a relevant representation and requested to continue as an interested party to take part in the examination of the Application. Further to this, a meeting was held between Shell and the Applicant to discuss the issues raised in the relevant representation and the potential impacts of Hornsea Three on Shell's offshore apparatus.
- 1.4 On the basis of the current proposals made available to Shell, there appear to be nine Shell pipelines which the proposed route will affect. The affected pipelines have been listed in Shell's representation dated 20 September 2017.
- 1.5 The Applicant acknowledges and agrees that to the extent the listed pipelines and the area 200 metres either side of each pipeline ("Pipeline Corridor") cannot be avoided, it will not carry out any works (including sampling and investigations) within the Pipeline Corridor unless and until it has first entered into a proximity and crossing agreement with Shell, on terms considered reasonable by both parties.
- 1.6 Further, the Applicant acknowledges that it will notify Shell of any works (including sampling and investigations) to be undertaken within 300 metres either side of each Pipeline Corridor.
- 1.7 [Shell and the Applicant will work together to agree the form of proximity and crossing agreements]. It is intended that these agreements will be progressed after the conclusion of the Examination process and when more detailed designs of the Hornsea Three export cable route have been prepared.
