I am an interested party in as much as we buy shellfish from many fishermen the work from the North Norfolk Coast.

I am concerned that in the event the fishermen themselves receive monetary compensation for not fishing in areas during the construction phase, our business is starved of product to process.

We see this happen before during the construction phase on the Race Bank and Dudgeon Windfarms.

We employ 70 staff and have purchased over around £1.3million worth of shellfish from local fishermen over the last 12 months.

To be able to plan ahead for the business I need to know I am able to purchase enough crab and lobster to build the business going forward.

If ORSTED are serious about being good local partners then they should help us with a financial package throughout this period of construction and compensation paid to fishermen.
