RE: EGGBOROUGH COMBINED CYCLE GAS TURBINE (CCGT) – DEADLINE 8

The Marine Management Organisation (MMO) has reviewed the matters within your Rule 8 Letter dated 04 October 2017 and the following constitutes the MMO's formal response to matters within Deadline 8.

The MMO received notification on 28 June 2017 stating that the Planning Inspectorate (PINS) on behalf of the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy had accepted an application from Eggborough Power Limited ("the Applicant"), for a Development Consent Order (DCO) for The Eggborough Combined Cycle Gas Turbine (CCGT; 'the Generating Station').

The MMO has an interest in this project because the development contains the construction of an outfall for a water discharge point as well as cofferdams on the River Aire. The DCO application includes a Deemed Marine Licence (DML) under Section 65 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009 (MCAA 2009). Should consent be granted, the MMO will be the delivery body responsible for monitoring, varying and enforcing the DML and any conditions within.

Deadline eight consists of the following:

- Comments on the Examining Authority's (ExA) draft DCO (if required)
- Updated Statements of Common Ground
- Updated Compulsory Acquisition schedule
- Responses to further information requested by the ExA

Of these items, the MMO considers that the matters in relation to the ExA's suggested amendments to the Applicants draft DCO are relevant.
