# **Notification of Procedural Decisions and Amended Examination Timetable**

I am writing to you following my letter of 26 February 2020, which provided you with my Examination Timetable, Written Questions and notification of hearings.

The Inspectorate in accordance with recent Government advice has updated the Wheelabrator Kemsley K3/WKN project page regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19), which includes a notice pertaining to the hearings scheduled for the week commencing 13 April 2020:

In accordance with the Government's measures to reduce the infection, which includes stopping all gatherings of more than two people in public and requiring people to stay at home, I have made the procedural decision to postpone the hearings scheduled for the week commencing 13 April 2020 as notified in my letter of 26 February 2020. Please refer to the amended Examination Timetable attached at **Annex A**.

This is a decision to **postpone** and not to cancel these events. I remain appointed and am now reviewing the procedures for this Examination. I am sure that you will understand my decision on this matter, considering these unprecedented times.



I have also decided to cancel the Accompanied Site Inspection and Open Floor Hearing reserved for Wednesday 15 April 2020.

In my Rule 8 letter I set a deadline by which IPs were requested to notify me of their wish to speak and/or confirm their wish to hold an OFH, being D1 (2 March 2020).

My Examination will be principally undertaken through written procedures, where I am required to hold an OFH in certain circumstances i.e. where Interested Parties request in writing that an OFH should be held. If no written requests are received, I am not required to hold these hearings.

I thank Minster on Sea Parish Council (MSPC) for their shortlist of possible venues to host the OFH (as requested by the Examining Authority at the Preliminary Meeting), however I received no written request to hold any OFH from any IPs by D1 and therefore the evening reserved for the OFH on 15 April 2020 will not take place.

### The Examination Timetable

In order to facilitate the ongoing progress of this Examination, I have now revised the Examination Timetable in accordance with my procedural decisions above.

I have made provision for an additional round of Written Questions if required, to be issued by 9 April 2020. Questions or further information requested would relate to matters that I would have intended to include in the Hearing agendas. Responses would be required by Deadline 3 (22 April 2020) with comments on responses required by Deadline 4 (20 May 2020).

The Examination process is primarily a written one and I encourage parties to continue discussions on outstanding matters and prepare information and written submissions where it is possible and safe to do so. With this in mind, discussions should continue pursuant to the submission of updated draft Development Consent Orders, Statements of Common Ground and any further information that I may request.

In this respect, I would like to emphasise that **Deadlines 3** onwards still, at this moment, apply in the Examination timetable. Where circumstances clearly related to the COVID-19 pandemic make it difficult for approaching deadlines to be met, I will of course give full consideration to whether an extension should be permitted. I will continue to consider potential changes to the Examination Timetable in light of the emerging situation.

The Wheelabrator K3/WKN project page will continue to be the main point of reference for notifications about the Examination and if necessary, publication of requests for further information under Rule 17 of the Examination Procedure Rules.

At this stage, there is clearly uncertainty regarding the ability to hold future events including those scheduled in the Examination Timetable for the w/c 15 June 2020 which I will keep under review. A variation of the timetable has been made now under Rule 8(3) and this is contained in **Annex A** of this letter at items, 6 to 19.
