In response to ExQ3.5.1 a draft Ecological Mitigation and Management Plan (EMMP) for WKN has been provided.

At Deadline 5 the Applicant has submitted signed versions of Statements of Common Ground with the Environment Agency (Document 8.2) and with Natural England (Document 8.3), alongside a draft Statement of Common Ground with Swale Borough Council (Document 8.1). The Applicant has submitted, as requested, a Statement of Commonality (Document 8.6) which summarises the progress relating to the various SoCG's and matters of commonality between them.

The Applicant remains in discussion with Kent County Council and with Highways England regarding their respective SoCG's, a summary of which is provided in the Statement of Commonality.

An updated version of the Application Guide [Document 1.2] has also been provided.
