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Thanet Extension Written Representation – The Crown Estate

The Crown Estate manages property and rights which are owned by Her Majesty in right of the Crown. This portfolio includes around half of the foreshore and almost the entire seabed out to 12 nautical miles around the UK. Under the Energy Act 2004 and the Energy Act 2008, The Crown Estate also manages the rights over the continental shelf to offshore energy generation and the rights to carbon dioxide and natural gas storage and transportation (respectively).

This written representation is provided in order to amend our relevant representation submitted on 03 August 2018 as follows:

Vattenfall Wind Power Ltd has submitted an application for the proposed project extension to The Crown Estate. This application is currently subject to a plan-level Habitats Regulations Assessment (HRA) which will assess any possible impact of the proposed project (alongside seven other extensions project applications) on relevant nature conservation sites of European importance. Subject to the outcomes of the plan-level HRA, Thanet Extension would be granted an agreement for lease in summer 2019. We therefore wish to follow the progress of examination of the project.
