## Notification of hearings and Accompanied Site Inspection 1

We write to all Interested Parties to announce the dates, times and places of forthcoming hearings which will be held between 19 and 21 February 2019, and the date, time and meeting place for Accompanied Site Inspection 1 on 18 February 2019. Important details about both are set out at **Annex A** and **Annex B** to this letter, respectively.

#### **Hearings**

As set out in the Examination Timetable annexed to our Rule 8 letter dated 18 December 2018, those Interested Parties who wish to speak at hearings were asked to notify the Planning Inspectorate by 15 January 2019 (Deadline 1).

- At least one request to be heard at an Open Floor Hearing (OFH) was received from an Interested Party and consequently the hearing designated as OFH1 in the Examination Timetable (in February 2019) must be held. At this stage, it appears that OFH2 (in April 2019) may not be required, but a formal decision on that question will be made and notice will be provided on 12 March 2019 if OFH2 is to proceed.
- At least one request to be heard at a Compulsory Acquisition Hearing (CAH) was
  received from an Affected Person and consequently such a hearing must also be
  held. We have decided to use the hearing designated as CAH1 in the Examination
  Timetable (in February 2019) to hear the Applicant's case for compulsory
  acquisition and temporary possession in strategic terms. It follows that we will use
  the hearing designated as CAH2 in the Examination Timetable (in April 2019) to
  hear individual objections to compulsory acquisition and/ or temporary possession



- and therefore CAH2 must also be held. Formal notice of CAH2 will be provided on 12 March 2019.
- We have also decided that all those Issue Specific Hearings (ISHs) provided to be held in February 2019 in the Examination Timetable will proceed, for the purposes set out in the timetable. A final formal decision on the need for and content of ISHs reserved in the timetable to be held in April 2019 will be made and notice will be provided on 12 March 2019.

Details of and arrangements for all hearings to be held in February 2019 are set out at **Annex A**.

We would be grateful if you would inform us if you plan to attend any of the hearings to be held in February 2019 (even if you do not wish to speak) **no later than 12 February 2019**. It would also assist us if you could notify the Planning Inspectorate's Case Team of any special requirements you may have (eg disabled access, hearing loop etc). Please ensure that you include your Interested Party reference number in your correspondence (provided either in the email covering this letter or on the postcard you have received).

An agenda for each of the hearings will be published on our website no later than one week before each event.

If any hearing arrangements need to be changed, reasonable notice will be provided to Interested Parties of our decision.

# **Accompanied Site Inspections**

As set out in the Examination Timetable annexed to our Rule 8 letter dated 18 December 2018, those Interested Parties who wished to nominate locations for and/ or to attend an Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI) were asked to notify the Planning Inspectorate by 15 January 2019 (Deadline 1).

A number of location nominations and attendance requests have been made. We also wish to invite certain Interested Parties to attend.

**The Applicant** set out site inspection proposals in its Deadline 1 Submission Appendix 32 [REP1-002]:

- We have considered the Applicant's proposals for an ASI to certain locations relevant to seascape, landscape and visual impact assessment (SLVIA) set out in paragraphs 3 4 (Table 1) of that submission. As explained in the Preliminary Meeting, we have already commenced a programme of unaccompanied site inspections (USIs) to a sample of locations relevant to SLVIA [EV-001], [EV-008]. The USI programme is not complete and further USIs will be held. Summary reports of them will continue to be published on the website. In the absence of a specific requirement to be accompanied on inspections held at locations in the public domain, we have decided that it is not necessary to hold an ASI to the locations nominated in the Applicant's Table 1, but we will add these to the USI programme.
- We have considered the Applicant's proposals that we should inspect locations on private land at Richborough relevant to the onshore cable route, substation and grid connection as set out in Appendix 32 in paras 5 – 6 (Table 2) and agree to all



of these proposals. Details of and arrangements for an ASI to Richborough to be held in February 2019 are set out at **Annex B**.

Port of Tilbury London Ltd (PoTLL) and London Gateway Port Ltd (LGPL) have requested [REP1-088] that we should inspect their operational port facilities and development proposals, located in the Thurrock Council area. We have considered this request and taking the nature of submissions on port and navigation effects made to the Examination into account, we have agreed to it. We agree that because of the specialist, potentially hazardous and access-controlled nature of port operations, the inspection must be an ASI. Details of and arrangements for an ASI to port facilities in Thurrock, Essex to be held in April 2019 will be the subject of formal notice to be provided on 12 March 2019.

**Final itineraries** for ASIs will be published on the National Infrastructure Planning website no later than one week before each event, once the Applicant, relevant land owners and operators have finalised their access, security, health and safety arrangements.

A number of other Interested Parties have requested to attend ASIs and additional provisional attendance arrangements can be found in **Annex B**, although it should be noted that final attendance arrangements taking account of access, security and safety arrangements will be confirmed in the final itineraries.

If any ASI is no longer required or arrangements need to be changed, reasonable notice will be provided to Interested Parties of our decision to cancel it. As provided for in our procedural decision 4 of 18 December 2018, in unforeseeable circumstances such as severe weather, the ExA reserves the right to amend or defer an ASI or part of it by notice posted on the website and/ or oral notice at the event start location, at any time up to the advertised start time.

The following land is in scope:

- Onshore cable alignment locations (Baypoint Sports Club, Crostline and BCA Sports Solutions);
- The proposed substation site; and
- The proposed grid connection location in Richborough Energy Park.

Representatives of the Applicant, the owners and occupiers of the land, Dover District Council, Thanet District Council and Kent Country Council are invited to attend.

Attendees will travel from the meeting place to locations in Richborough relevant to the onshore cable corridor, substation and grid connection proposals, using their own private transport. Detailed site inspections within private land will be made on foot.

Attendees who do not have their own means of transport or who have special transport needs are requested to contact the Case Team by emailing <a href="mailto:ThanetExtension@pins.gsi.gov.uk">ThanetExtension@pins.gsi.gov.uk</a> no later than 6 February 2019 so that transport and access arrangements can be made.

A detailed itinerary will be published on the website no later than one week before the event, to take account of any access, security, health and safety arrangements advised by the Applicant and/or the owners or occupiers of the land.

Attendees are requested to arrive at the meeting place by 12 noon to receive a compulsory safety briefing and introductory remarks from the Planning Inspectorate. The ASI will commence as soon as possible after these are concluded.

The inspection will largely be on foot and include walking on uneven or wet ground. Winter weather conditions may be expected. The Planning Inspectorate therefore advises attendees to wear clothing that is appropriate for the weather, and sturdy footwear. Certain sites may have additional requirements for personal protective equipment (PPE) to be worn. The reasonable directions of site managers provided in the interests of health and safety must be observed. If severe weather or other unforeseen circumstances emerge, this ASI may be cancelled or re-arranged as



published on the website at any time prior to the meeting time, or by oral notice provided at the meeting location.

The Applicant is requested to engage with the landowners/ occupiers and to advise the Case Team **no later than 6 February 2019 of** any advance requirements and arrangements for security, access and PPE use, for inclusion in the final itinerary.
