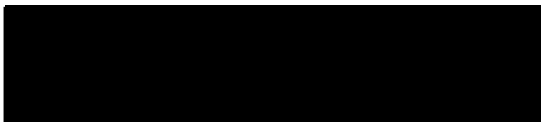

Further information**

With reference to your letter of 21st November requesting further information, I can provide the following update on behalf of the National Trust in response to paragraph 6 of that letter.

I can confirm that The National Trust and Vattenfall have agreed Heads of Terms whereby, should the DCO be granted by the Secretary of State, Vattenfall would not exercise powers of compulsory purchase over the Trust's land affected and the Trust would withdraw its objection to the DCO. An option agreement has been drawn up from the Heads of terms, has been signed by both parties and is due to be formally completed by the parties very shortly.
