Dear Hefin,

As we are expecting the Accompanied Site Inspection on the 24<sup>th</sup> July to include our South Swale Nature Reserve (encompassing the land from the dyke landward of the sea wall, the sea wall itself, and the intertidal area adjacent), please consider this email a request for a representative of Kent Wildlife Trust to be present. This is likely to be the site warden, Laura Steuart (copied in).

The reasons for this are twofold:

1) While the Reserve can be walked through via the Public Right of Way (as per the Unaccompanied Site Inspection), you may wish to stray from this. You have our consent to do so (excluding Castle Coote), but as we are anticipating a large group our warden can help you avoid inadvertently disturbing sensitive species.

2) Our warden will be able to answer questions the Inspector may have regarding the wildlife and management of the Nature Reserve.

Please note that grazing animals are likely to be present on the Reserve.
