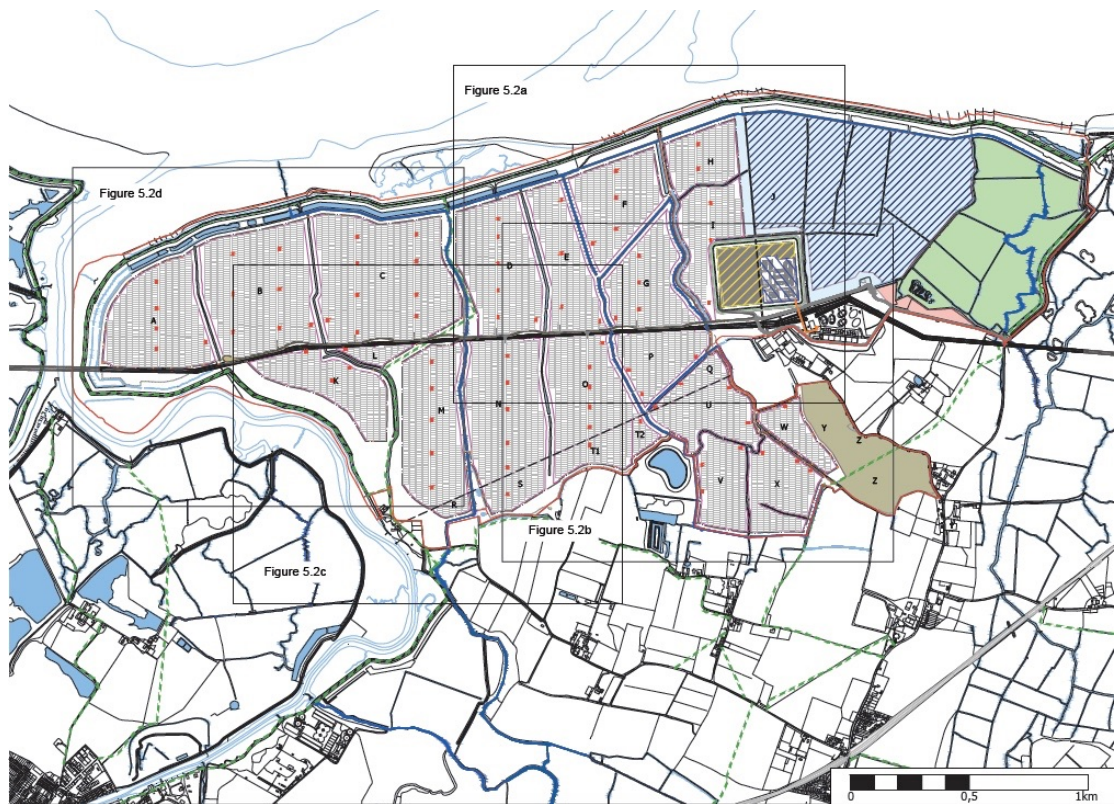

To Whom it may concern I am writing to make representation against the proposed development of Cleve Hill Solar Park.

I object to this plan.

900 acres of valuable carbon collecting marshland - (home to over 70 species of birds and animals including the rare endangered European eel) covered in solar panels, 25 metres wide x 3.9 meters high x 2 1/2 miles deep. I believe this area should be subject to Managed Realignment as previously planned.

I am concerned about the Batteries. 20 acres of unproven, container sized Batteries- sited on the marshes. If they catch fire - and many have already in other parts of the world, they will release Hydrofluoric gas into the air, which will fall as Hydrofluoric acid

The experts recommendation is for the Batteries to be placed at least 15 kilometers from human habitation. Canterbury, Faversham, Graveney, Whitstable, Herne Hill, Sheppey, with a combined population of 155,000 are within a radius of 15 kilometers.

I urge you to reject these plans.
