The meeting place is the car park at the Necton Costa Café and Tuns Lane Co-op. Access is from Rudge Way off the A47 or from Tuns Lane. The address is 2, Rudge Way, Necton, PE37 8EH. (This is a new development with new road layout, therefore if attending, you are advised to consult a map and not rely solely on the postcode).

Areas to be visited on this ASI will be the substations site at Necton and surroundings, and Cawston. Other requested locations will be considered for inclusion in a future ASI.
