Dear Sirs,

Please be aware that the designated route for the above schemes will now pass through a Natural England Nature Recovery Project (NRP) at grid reference TF 98059 15351 (and surrounding area).

This will be one of five Natural England nature recovery projects in the UK and is also a BNG credit scheme pilot. It will ultimately cover approx. 2000 acres and will see approx. 3.2KM of Vattenfall cable route cross it. Due to the delay in planning for Vanguard, and Boreas not currently having a DCO, work will now commence on the Nature Recovery Project well before construction work on the cable route, meaning that there will be a material change in the existing land use and biodiversity baseline once construction gets under way.

Whilst we will look to work with Vattenfall to plan ahead and minimise the impact, we wanted to make you aware of this development as it is a change from when plans were first submitted.
