Thank you for your email dated 18 November 2022 inviting East Suffolk Council to comment on the Applicant's submitted Kittiwake Implementation and Monitoring Plan (KIMP) and associated documents, in accordance with the Norfolk Boreas and Norfolk Vanguard Offshore Windfarm Orders.

As set out in the Applicant's submission 'Annex 1: Kittiwake Compensation Consultation Report', on 24 October 2022, ESC confirmed to the Applicant that:

- 1. the Kittiwake Agreement Log is an accurate reflection of our position on all matters for which we wish to engage on;
- 2. the Council has engaged and contributed to the KIMP, and following a careful review, the contents are agreed.

Planning permission for the installation of the artificial nesting structure for kittiwakes at the Port of Lowestoft (DC/22/3202/FUL) was granted on 5 October 2022.
