The Proposed Development comprises a gas-fired electricity generating station with a capacity of more than 50MW (up to 299MW gross output capacity) and associated development. Therefore, it represents a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP), pursuant to section 14(1)(a) and 15(2) of the Planning Act 2008. As such, a Development Consent Order (DCO) for the Proposed Development is required pursuant to section 31 of the Planning Act 2008. Development consent may only be granted by a DCO following the submission of an application to the Secretary of State pursuant to section 37 of the Planning Act 2008.

The Application seeks consent to construct, operate (including maintenance) and decommission a gas-fired electricity generating station of up to 299MW at the existing West Burton Power Station site. The Proposed Development would comprise up to five Open Cycle Gas Turbines and associated buildings, structures and plant, as well as associated development. The Proposed Development Site comprises land within the boundary of the existing West Burton Power Station site, near Gainsborough, Nottinghamshire. The part of the West Burton Power Station site where the proposed power plant would be sited is located approximately 3.5km to the south-west of Gainsborough and 1km to the north-east of Sturton-le-Steeple. The Proposed Development Site is located to the north of West Burton B Power Station, centered on national grid reference 480275, 386241. A more detailed description of the Proposed Development Site is provided in Chapter 3 'Description of the Site and its Surroundings' of the Environmental Statement Volume I (Application Document Ref 5.2).
