

WEST BURTON C POWER STATION

ACCOMPANIED SITE INSPECTION: APPLICANT'S DRAFT ITINERARY

Background

The Rule 8 letter (dated 6th November 2019) states that week commencing 20th January 2020 has been reserved for the Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI). Comments on suggested locations/sites for the Examining Authority to include as part of the ASI must be submitted by Deadline 1 (20th November 2019). The Applicant's draft itinerary for the ASI must also be submitted by Deadline 1.

Itinerary

The ASI will focus primarily on the proposed Power Station site, the points of access and surrounding viewpoints. The suggested route for the ASI is shown on the Draft ASI Route Plan, appended to this note (**Appendix A**).

The Applicant will provide a minibus (or other appropriate means of transport) for the site visit, but a small amount of walking will be required.

Notification of attendees is required to enquiries@westburtonc.co.uk by Deadline 3 to enable us to ensure the availability of transport and site access, owing to the Christmas/New Year break.

The site visit can be completed over one day and provide adequate time to visit the site in detail.


