14	<u>Consent</u> <u>removed</u>	The need for a Standard Rules Permit for temporary construction works within the construction laydown area in Flood Zone 1 was included in the Application on a precautionary basis. It has been agreed through the Statement of Common Ground with the Environment Agency, submitted at Deadline 1 (REP1-016), that that a Standard Rules Permit would not be required for temporary construction works within the Construction Laydown Area that may need to take place in Flood Zone 2, given the very small area affected (<1ha)
