



In July 2017, RWE announced plans to develop future energy options at its site in Tilbury. In February this year, we held non-statutory public consultation on the proposed development called Tilbury Energy Centre. Since then we have conducted many feasibility studies, environmental assessments and surveys to enable the submission of a DCO.

RWE has recently concluded an evaluation of its UK energy options. Unfortunately, as a consequence of this evaluation the decision has been taken to freeze the Tilbury Energy Centre development. The decision to freeze Tilbury Energy Centre has not been taken lightly. Inevitably it will be a disappointment for those who have been working so hard to get us to the stage we have reached.

As always RWE will constantly explore development options for its Tilbury site, which remains a good site for future energy options. In the meantime, I would be grateful if you could update your website to reflect the fact that the project will not be progressed.
