1 Context

1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 DS Smith Paper Ltd are seeking a Development Consent Order to allow for the construction and operation of a replacement Combined Heat and Power (CHP) Plant, 'K4', at the Kemsley Paper Mill to the north of Sittingbourne in Kent.
- 1.1.2 The project is a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project under Section 14 and Section 15 of the Planning Act 2008 as it comprises an onshore generating station with a thermal capacity of more than 50 megawatts. An application for a Development Consent Order must therefore be made to the Planning Inspectorate, with a final decision on the application to be taken by the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy.
- 1.1.3 The draft Order is 'The Kemsley Mill K4 Combined Heat and Power Generating Station Development Consent Order'.
- 1.1.4 This Document, 1.4, forms part of the DCO application and provides copies of the notices placed in newspapers prior to the application being submitted.

1.2 Legislative Context

- 1.2.1 S42 of the Planning Act 2008 requires the applicant to consult various bodies on the proposed application, including (a) such persons as may be prescribed, (b) each local authority that is within section 43, (c) the Greater London Authority if the land is in Greater London, and (d) each person who is within one or more of the categories set out in section 44.
- 1.2.2 Regulation 13 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 [The 2017 EIA Regulations] requires the applicant, at the same time as publishing notice of the proposed application under S48(1), to send a copy of that notice to the consultation bodies and to any person notified to the applicant in accordance with regulation 11(1)(c).
- 1.2.3 S47 of the Planning Act 2008 requires the applicant to prepare a statement setting out how the application proposes to consult, about the proposed application, people living in the vicinity of the land. Section 47(6) (as amended by the Localism Act 2011) states that the applicant must make the statement available for inspection by the public, in a way that is reasonably convenient for people living in the vicinity of the land, and must publish in a newspaper circulating in the vicinity of the land a notice stating where and when the statement can be inspected.
- 1.2.4 S48 of the Planning Act 2008 requires the application to publicise the application in the prescribed manner.

1.3 Newspaper Notices

I write on behalf of DS Smith Paper Ltd, who intend to apply to the Secretary of State under Section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 ("the Act") for a Development Consent Order to allow for the construction and operation of a Combined Heat and Power (CHP) Plant at the Kemsley Mill, to the north of Sittingbourne in Kent.

The proposed CHP plant would have a nominal power output of 68 to 73 Megawatts and would provide electricity and steam to the DS Smith paper mill. It would be constructed within the main paper mill site and would comprise a complex of buildings including a gas turbine, a heat recovery steam generator with a 70m stack, a dump condenser, a turbine hall, an auxiliary package boiler with a 35 metre stack and other ancillary infrastructure, buildings and plant.

Section 42 of The Act requires the applicant to consult various prescribed bodies and statutory undertakers about the proposed application, together with directly affected and adjoining local authorities. For the purposes of the consultation under Section 42 the enclosed CD contains a draft of the Environmental Statement (ES) being prepared to accompany the DCO application, which provides a full description of the proposed development. The ES is supported by a Non-Technical Summary and by a draft plan set to illustrate the location and scale of the proposed development.

As the proposed development requires Environmental Impact Assessment the applicant is required by Regulation 11 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009 (as amended) ("the EIA Regulations"), to send prescribed consultees a copy of the notice publicising the

THERE was no shortage of bridge action to follow online at the weekend. Events on BBO included the Reykjavik Bridge Festival, the EBU Lady Milne (women's home international) pair trial, the Irish trials and the Israeli trials.

This deal from the Lady Milne pairs trial caught my eye. North-South were a London partnership, Marusa Basa and Susanna Gross; East-West the experienced Yorkshire duo, Sandy Davies and Carole Kelly.

The Slovenian-born Basa, a useful recruit to the English women's bridge scene, had an

against the Kieff Rada and General Kaledin. Their grievance against the Kieff Rada is twofold. First, the Rada does not recognise the Bolshevik Government, and has disarmed and disbanded the Bolshevik troops in Southern Russia, and concluded a military alliance with Roumania and General Kaledin. And secondly, the Ukrainians, by negotiating independently with the Central Powers, have seriously complicated Trotsky's policy. A split between Austria and Germany would give Trotsky a trump card in the negotiations. But the South-Western front facing Austria is in Ukrainian hands. If Ukraine makes a separate peace with the Central Powers, this will primarily affect Austria. The Austro-Russian front ceases to exist, and then Austria, having secured peace for herself, no longer has any direct interest in opposing the excessive German pretensions in Northern Russia, which now protract and complicate the negotiations. This explains the present acute indignation of the Bolsheviks against the Ukrainians, and their determination to overthrow the Kieff Rada.

They are acting both by military force and political stratagem. In Kharkoff they have set up a rival Bolshevik Ukrainian Government, and are trying to agitate among the Ukrainian soldiers. A recent attempt to provoke a rising in Kieff was frustrated by the disarmament of the local Red Guard by the Ukrainian Government. From the north and east Bolshevik forces from time to time make more or less successful raids into Ukrainian territory, and Bolshevik troops from the Roumanian and South-Western front indulge in frequent skirmishes with the Rada's troops within Ukraine.

Matters are further complicated by the struggle between the Roumanian and Russian troops. The Roumanians are now waging a regular battle with the Ninth Siberian Division near Galatz. Kharkoff, however, is the real centre of the Bolshevik military operations. Here a staff under Antonoff sits in a railway carriage, and, directing its forces against the Ukraine on one side and the Don on the other, tries to cut communication between the two autonomous territories. The forces at Antonoff's disposal consist of sailors, soldiers, Red Guards, and German and Austrian prisoners. A certain success was achieved against the Ukraine in the capture of Poltava Ekaterinoslav, and Alexandrovsk, but the Ukraine has recovered Ekaterinoslav and Alexandrovsk.

Giri gets his chance

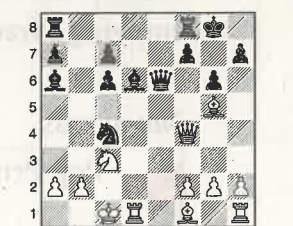
ONE couldn't have wished for a better climax to the Tata Steel tournament at Wijk aan Zee, as Anish Giri, the great hope of Dutch chess, was tied for the lead with world champion Magnus Carlsen going into the 13th and final round.

It is 33 years since Jan Timman won the tournament on home soil. Carlsen ground down Maxim Matlakov from what was a slightly better, but seemingly unwinnable rook and opposite-bishop endgame, while Giri outplayed Baskaran Adhiban, won a pawn and never looked back.

Shak Mamedyarov fell off the pace when he played an unusual line of the Petroff Defence, which Gawain Jones was not expecting. Jones had assumed that his opponent would play for the win and, in unfamiliar territory, he forced a quick draw by repetition.
