Dear Kemsley K4 planning team,

Thank you for notifying Natural England of the Rule 17 letter regarding the Applicant's amended documents proposing a change to increase the maximum height of the gas turbine building to 14.5m.

I can confirm that Natural England is satisfied that the change to the height of the gas turbine building does not change the conclusions of the air quality modelling, for the reasons set out in paragraph 5.3.34 of the revised Air Quality chapter of the ES (December 2018 version). The conclusions regarding potential air quality impacts on designated nature conservation sites are, therefore, unchanged, and so we have no further comment to make.
