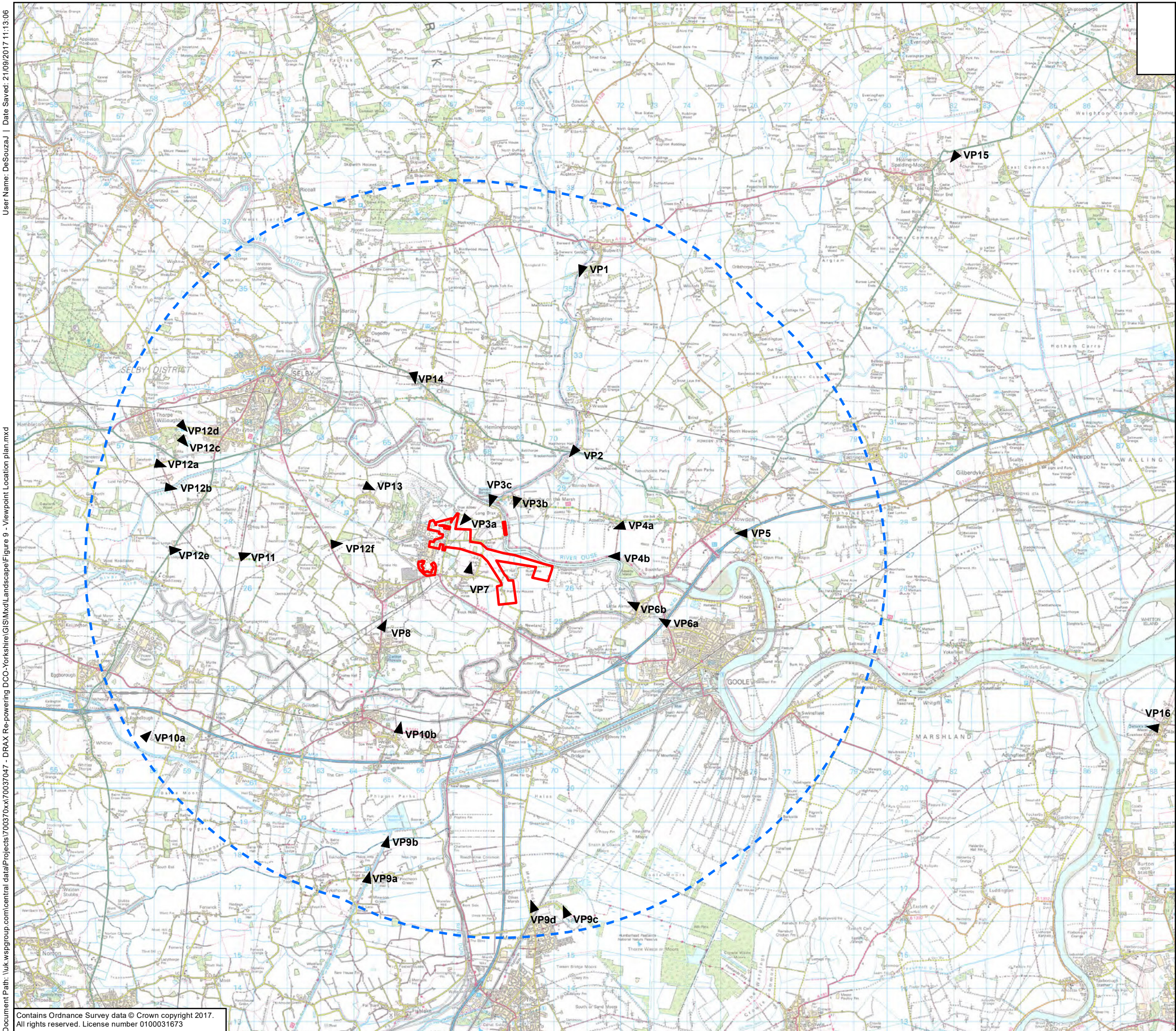
Apologies for the late response. I am aware that these comments will not be taken into consideration as part of the Scoping Response but that you will forward these onto the applicant for information purposes.

On behalf of Doncaster MBC I can confirm that there is deemed to be little potential for adverse environmental impacts to result from the proposed development and are content with the ES Scoping Document. We have, however, been in discussions with the applicant's Landscape Team to discuss the LVIA in more detail. In summary, we have agreed that the scope of the LVIA looks well thought out. Specifically, the viewpoint proposed in the Sykehouse area of the Borough will serve to show what the potential visual impacts will be for the outer-lying satellite settlements in this more rural area of Doncaster. A suggestion has, however, been put forward by Doncaster MBC for an additional viewpoint location to be included from the Thorne/Moorends area (where there is also a Peatlands Way track). This is a quite dense settlement (in an area earmarked for Growth in the Development Plan). This has been accepted by the Landscape Team (indicated as 'Viewpoint 9c & 9d' on the attached draft plan) and is welcomed by the Council.
