## Request for further information

Having considered the evidence submitted during the Examination particularly in respect of the Proposed Development's individual contribution towards energy need, as well as the total greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions that would be generated, the Examining Authority (ExA) is interested to explore other options that may be available to the Secretary of State (SoS) including, a decision which supports granting consent for Unit X alone. In order to examine this option, it is necessary for the ExA to request from the Applicant the following information:

- A summary of the implications, if any, of an Order being made that grants development consent for Unit X only;
- Explanation as to whether information provided thus far is sufficient to support
  this approach, particularly with regards to the assessment of significant effects
  in relation to the total increase in GHG emissions and the relationship between
  a Unit X only option alongside the existing Coal Unit 5 or 6. The Applicant's
  answer in this regard should take into account information previously provided
  when responding to Written Question ANC1.12 [REP2-035]; and
- Can the Applicant explain what modifications that would be required to the draft Development Consent Order [REP7-003] for a Unit X only option.
