The Applicant and Thurrock Council have been in continuing discussions around the Council's original request for a section 106 as identified in the Council's LIR. Having established the detail of the request, the parties consider that these could be appropriately dealt with under Protective Provisions and the addition of one further requirement on education and skills addressing in particular how the Applicant will seek to deliver local employment opportunities. The items under discussion for the Protective Provisions relate to local highway issues, including a request for a commitment by the Applicant to fund road condition surveys and remediation of damage, which the Applicant has agreed to in principle.

As a result Thurrock Council advises that there will not be a need for a s106 agreement for this DCO application as all mitigation matters can be dealt with through other tools within the DCO.
