Thank you for sending through the link to the revised DCO Order.

I can confirm that the June 2021 - Version 6 of the Order now includes Protective Provisions requested by Anglian Water and set out in the March 2021 Statement of Common Ground.

Please accept this email as confirmation that Anglian Water is content for TPL as the project promoter to advise the Examining Authority that the issues set out in Anglian Water's Relevant Representation have now been resolved.

I would be grateful if you could advise me of the details of the TPL colleague who will be progressing the water supply and waste water matters as part of the DCO Implementation Plan. If that person is not yet identified please can you include within the DCO Implementation Plan a step to contact Anglian Water to confirm the approach to the matters in Schedule, 9 Part 2 and advise of a prospective date when that step is planned to take place. To assist in taking these matters forward with other parties the Implementation Plan may identify that discussions and agreements are progressed in parallel or jointly with the Environment Agency and the Lead Local Flood Authority. This is in part to ensure that surface water is managed by SuDS agreed with those parties rather than connections to the waste water network.
