This document comprises the Marine Management Organisation's (MMO) Deadline 8 response in respect to the above Development Consent Order (DCO) Application. This is without prejudice to any future representation the MMO may make about the DCO Application throughout the examination process. This is also without prejudice to any decision the MMO may make on any associated application for consent, permission, approval or any other type of authorisation submitted to the MMO either for the works in the marine area or for any other authorisation relevant to the proposed development.

After discussing with Thurrock Council the MMO can confirm we are content for Requirement 19 to stay within Schedule 2, Part 1 'Requirements' of the DCO.
