1. Update on the Status of Discussions to secure an agreement in relation to the Alternative AIL Access Route

- 1.1 RWE can confirm that negotiations in respect of the Alternative AIL Access Route have been successfully concluded and that an option agreement between RWE and the Applicant has been exchanged today.
