In relation to the letter dated 16th Nov, ref EN010093, LB Newham would make the following comments:

- As a Council we were generally aware of the intentions to expand the Belvedere Riverside Energy site as Cory had approached the Mayor of Newham for a meeting (it was not clear what the purpose of the meeting was and there was no follow-up).
- We are not of the view that we have any record of Cory having engaged with Newham in its LPA function in any formal pre-application sense; for example the Council was not aware that the proposal was / had proceeded to formal submission.
- While we have no specific views to express on the 'adequacy' of this situation, we cannot confirm that the developer has complied with the duties referenced in your letter.

We wish to confirm that should the examination proceed, Newham would wish to be recorded as an Interested Party and given the opportunity to make representations.
