In relation to the letter dated 16^{th} Nov, ref EN010093, LB Newham would make the following comments:

- As a Council we were generally aware of the intentions to expand the Belvedere
 Riverside Energy site as Cory had approached the Mayor of Newham for a meeting (it
 was not clear what the purpose of the meeting was and there was no follow-up).
- We are not of the view that we have any record of Cory having engaged with Newham in its LPA function in any formal pre-application sense; for example the Council was not aware that the proposal was / had proceeded to formal submission.
- While we have no specific views to express on the 'adequacy' of this situation, we cannot confirm that the developer has complied with the duties referenced in your letter.
- We wish to confirm that should the examination proceed, Newham would wish to be recorded as an Interested Party and given the opportunity to make representations.
