## **RE: Riverside Energy Park**

The Marine Management Organisation (MMO) recently received the "Rule 6" letter in relation to the application by Cory Riverside Energy ("the Applicant") for an order Granting Development Consent for the Riverside Energy Park Project on 13 March 2019.

The MMO responded to the letter confirming that we will not be attending the preliminary meeting, but that we remain an interested party. Having further reviewed the online documents, specifically "6.3 Environmental Statement Technical Appendices B.2 Navigational Risk Assessment" and "6.4 Environmental Statement Non-Technical Summary, section 5.1.6" the MMO has established that there do not appear to be any works within the UK Marine Area (Section 42, Marine & Coastal Access Act). As such it would seem that there are no licensable marine works which fall within our remit.

The MMO reserves the right to amend this position including if the plans for this project change and works are required within the Marine Environment.

If marine works are required, we strongly encourage the applicant to engage with the MMO to clarify any requirements for a marine licence whether standalone or 'deemed' within a Development Consent Order (DCO). Where a marine licence is deemed within a DCO, the MMO is the delivery body responsible for post-consent monitoring, variation, enforcement and revocation of provisions relating to the marine environment.
