Sirs,

In May 2018 I submitted a series of observations and questions based upon the Public Consultations provided by Cory Environmental in relation to their Riverside Energy Park. I anticipated a reply from Cory to these questions, however, I received a response that stated that my views would be included in the Cory submission. I am unaware of whether or where these submissions and questions have been addressed (document attached).

Consequently, I then continued with my submission as a Person of Specific Interest (document attached).

Further, I have read the Mayor's GLA Environmental Committee waste energy report of February 2018 and find it a highly credible and creditable document and fully support it and its Key Findings.(Key Findings attached)

I am also disappointed that, despite assurances of a response from two Senior Executives at Cory from two separate public meetings, I have yet to receive an answer to my enquiry regarding clarification to their public consultation(s) that I attended and was advised that this project was Low Carbon, Carbon Neutral as well as Carbon Negative. As I have stated previously, it clearly cannot be all three, but which is it ?

A further point of contention which remains unresolved is the issue of Ultra Fine Particulates. When this matter was raised at the London Borough of Bexley overview and scrutiny committee by Councillor Stefan Borella he got nothing in response in the form of a detailed and substantive reply. It is not clear that Cory have managed to provide any response to this concern either.(document attached)

I therefore submit my continuing concerns and unanswered questions for your consideration.
